- A. A resolution in the matter of final allocation of levy authority to all political subdivisions subject to County levy authority. (R-07-0080)

A resolution in the matter of adopting benefits for County employees in the Unclassified Service who are not covered by a labor agreement, excluding Deputy Sheriff Captains, effective the pay period beginning August 30, 2007.
