- 1) **MINUTES:** Approval of the minutes of the Board of Commissioners meeting held on Tuesday, August 28, 2007 and minutes of the public hearing held on Tuesday, August 14, 2007 at 7 p.m. regarding the Proposed Budget for Lancaster County for Fiscal Year 2007-2008. #### 4) **OLD BUSINESS**:

A. An agreement between Lancaster County and Lorena Pulgarin for project coordinator services for the Medical Translation and Interpretation Project. Term of the contract is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. The County's payment for such services will not exceed \$20,000. (C-07-0307)

#### 4) OLD BUSINESS CONTINUED:

B. An agreement with the Lancaster County Medical Society (LCMS) to enroll qualified Lancaster County Community Mental Health Center clients in national pharmaceutical discount programs and to provide related services, including medical record development, and the training of staff at the Community Mental Health Center. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. The program and \$1,000 per month for related services. (C-07-0331)

#### North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street and Alvo Road

- Install stop signs on North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street for northbound and southbound traffic at the Alvo Road intersection which will provide a four-way stop.
- ► Install 'all way' signs below each stop sign at the intersection.
- ► Install stop ahead signs. One for northbound traffic on North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street 500 feet south of the Alvo Road intersection and one for southbound traffic on North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street approximately 500 feet north of the Alvo Road intersection.

## Two months after installation of signage the following changes will be made at North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street and Alvo Road:

- Removal of stop signs on Alvo Road for eastbound and westbound traffic.
- Removal of the existing stop ahead sign on Alvo Road for westbound traffic.
- Removal of 'all way' signs below each stop sign at the intersection.
- ► Install 'Cross Traffic Does Not Stop' signs below the stop signs on North 162<sup>nd</sup> Street for northbound and southbound traffic. Remove these warning signs after a six-month adjustment period.

#### North 176<sup>th</sup> Street and Alvo Road

- ► Install stop signs on North 176<sup>th</sup> Street for northbound and southbound traffic at the Alvo Road intersection which will provide a four-way stop at the intersection.
- Install 'all way' signs below each stop sign at the intersection.
- ► Install stop ahead signs. One for northbound traffic on North 176<sup>th</sup> Street 500 feet south of the Alvo Road intersection and one for southbound traffic on North 176<sup>th</sup> Street 500 feet north of the Alvo Road intersection.

#### 5) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

Two months after installation of signage the following changes will be made at North 176<sup>th</sup> Street and Alvo Road:

- Removal of stop signs on Alvo Road for eastbound and westbound traffic.
- Removal of 'all way' signs below each stop sign at the intersection.
- ► Install 'Cross Traffic Does Not Stop' signs below the stop signs on North 176<sup>th</sup> Street for northbound and southbound traffic. Remove these warning signs after a six-month adjustment period.
- D. A resolution approving the issuance of not to exceed \$10,000,000 aggregate principal amount of Limited Tax Facility Bonds, Series 2007 of the Lancaster County Fairgrounds Joint Public Agency and directing County representatives to vote in favor of approval of an Amended and Restated Facilities Agreement between the Agency and the Lancaster County Agricultural Society. - E. An agreement with Arcadia Health Care for health care staffing services at the Lancaster County Community Mental Health Center. Term of the agreement is from July 1, 2007 to June 30, 2008. The County will pay registered nurses from \$36.95 to \$39.95. (C-07-0349)
- F. An addendum to an agreement with Behavioral Interventions (BI) Inc., County Contract C-04-0500, for monitoring services for the Lancaster County Community Corrections operation of electronic field monitoring devices. The addendum adds BI Cellular monitoring devices to the agreement which will enable electronic monitoring service to be installed without a telephone line connected to the Community Corrections client's home. The County will pay \$4.50 per unit, per day for each cellular unit provided. (C-07-0350)
- G. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice, Grant No. 07-CA-517, Legislative Bill 193 County Aid Grant, in the amount of \$190,686 and a match of \$76,274 for a total of \$266,960, covering the period from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. (C-07-0351)
- H. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice, Grant No. 06-JA-602, Block Grant Program, in the amount of \$63,506 and a match of \$7,056 for a total of \$70,562, covering the period from July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. (C-07-0352)
