- A. An agreement with the State of Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services (HHS), Division of Behavioral Health Services to provide youth problem gambling prevention services for the Gamblers Assistance Program. The County will receive \$50,000 from HHS through Legislative Bill (LB) 321, Health Care Cash Funds. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2008. (C-07-0511)
- B. An appraisal contract between the County Engineer and Johnson Appraisal, L.L.C. for appraisal services, in the amount of \$15,475, in connection with the appraisal of right-of-way for a project located on Pine Lake Road from South 112<sup>th</sup> Street to South 148th Streets; Project C55-Q-409(1). (C-07-0515)
- C. A grant contract with the City of Lincoln, Nebraska (Lincoln Police Department) to provide funding for Lincoln Police Department's Domestic Violence Specialist position in the amount of \$34,949. Term of the grant contract is June 1, 2007 to May 31, 2008. The City of Lincoln will contribute \$16,987 in matching funds. (C-07-0513)
