Don Thomas, County Engineer, gave a brief overview of the resolution.

Hudkins suggested the County road be cut down by approximately one foot.

An agreement with Dominion Diagnostics to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Dominion Diagnostics will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30-day termination clause. (C-07-0075)

**MOTION:** Stevens moved and Schorr seconded approval of an agreement with Dominion Diagnostics to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. Schorr, Hudkins, Stevens and Workman voted aye. Motion carried.

A grant contract with the United Methodist Ministries-Lincoln (Equity in Nebraska) for funding for the community-driven initiatives to address violence against women among diverse and traditionally under served populations while strengthening legal advocacy services for victims of domestic abuse and dating violence, in the amount of \$51,447. Term of the grant contract is January 1, 2007 to December 31, 2008. (C-07-0076)
