- E. A contract between Lancaster County, the City of Lincoln and Sapp Bros. Petroleum, Inc. for annual requirements of fuel. The County will pay for fuel according to the pricing in the contractor's accepted proposal. Term of the contract is one year from the date of execution. (C-08-0290)
- F. An application and agreement for nutrition services with the State of Nebraska, Department of Education Nutrition Services System. The application is under the Adult Care Food Program, on behalf of the Community Mental Health Center. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The State will reimburse the County up to \$26,000 for the program. (C-08-0291)
