The grant contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$300,000, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. A grant contract with Family Service Association Inc. for the following programs: Welcome Baby, in the amount of \$30,000; Behavioral Health Services, in the amount of \$179,000; Community Learning Center Youth Program, in the amount of \$26,000. Total amount of the grant contract is \$235,000 and the term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$235,000, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0519)

- K. A grant contract with Lincoln Action Program Inc. to provide funding for the following programs: Housing/Resource Counseling, in the amount of \$72,000; Homeless Voucher Program, in the amount of \$10,500; and the COLT (Coalition of Landlords and Tenants) Program, in the amount of \$30,000. Total amount of the grant contract is \$112,500 and term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. - L. A grant contract with Good Neighbor Center to provide an emergency food and clothes center for low income families in the Lincoln-Lancaster County area, in the amount of \$60,000. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$60,000, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0521)
- M. A grant contract with Cedars Youth Services to provide funds for the Intensive Diversion Program for juveniles, in the amount of \$35,000. The funds are Federal grant funds distributed through the U.S. Department of Justice. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. (C-08-0522)
- N. A grant contract with Heartland Big Brothers/Big Sisters for the Youth Development Program, in the amount of \$33,000. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. The contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$33,000, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0523)
- O. A grant contract with the Voices of Hope to provide funding for the Crisis Intervention Program, in the amount of \$22,500. Term of the grant contract is from July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. The contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$22,500, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0524)
- P. A grant contract with The HUB Inc. to provide funding for the Lincoln Education Outreach (LEO) Program, in the amount of \$20,000. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The contract will automatically renew for an additional 12-month period, in the amount of \$20,000, unless notification of termination is provided by the County prior to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0525)

- Q. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for the Juvenile Accountability Block Grant (JABG) Program. The County will receive \$70,586, of which \$7,086 is the County's match share. Term of the grant award is July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. (C-08-0526)
- R. An amendment to an interlocal agreement between Lancaster County and the State of Nebraska, Administrative Office of the Courts, for administration of the Adult Drug Court for the District Court of Lancaster County found at County Contract No. C-08-0289. The amendment adds one Drug Technician to the County staff administering Adult Drug Court and raises the amount the Administrative Office of the Courts will pay the County to \$183,839. (C-08-0527)
- S. An agreement between Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln for the provision of medical services to the Youth Services Center through the Lincoln-Lancaster County Health Department for the period of July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. (C-08-0528)
- T. An agreement between Marylou McGuire and Lancaster County for professional consulting services at Lancaster Manor. Term of the contract is from September 15, 2008 to September 14, 2009. The County will pay \$77.50 per hour for no more than 24 hours per week. (C-08-0529)
- U. An addendum to a contract between Lancaster County and Anacomp Inc. for the purchase of microfilming supplies on an as-needed basis found at County Contract No. C-07-0355. The addendum renews the contract for an additional term beginning August 15, 2008 and ending August 14, 2009, and reflects price increases as listed in Attachment A. (C-08-0530)
- V. A Recreational Trails Program Project agreement between Lancaster County, the Lower Platte South Natural Resources District (NRD) and the Nebraska Game and Parks Commission for the purpose of preliminary engineering design costs for the motocross track located at Ethel Abbott Sports Complex. The total design cost of the project is \$152,306.25. The County and the NRD agree to cover 20 percent of the costs and will be reimbursed for 80 percent of the total cost up to \$121,845 by the Federal Highway Administration. (C-08-0531)
