- A. A resolution in the matter of the vacation of a portion of West Simon Street abutting Lot 10, Block 1, and Lot 1, Block 2 of Werger's Addition to Martell, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (R-08-0082)
- B. A grant contract with Good Neighbor Center to provide an emergency food and clothes center for low income families in the Lincoln-Lancaster County area, in the amount of \$60,000. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Pathology Medical Service will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30 day termination provision. (C-08-0554)

- E. A grant contract with the People's City Mission for funding for the Family/Women's Shelter Program, in the amount of \$40,000, and the Day Shelter Program, in the amount of \$30,000. Total amount of the grant contract is \$70,000 and term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. (C-08-0555)
- F. A grant contract with El Centro de Las Americas to provide funding for the Domestic Violence Outreach program, in the amount of \$10,000. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2008 to June 30, 2009. (C-08-0556)

Acceptance of a grant award from the Department of Justice, Office on Violence Against Women for the Grants to Encourage Arrest Policies and Enforcement of Protection Orders Program, in the amount of \$400,000. This is a continuation grant award. The project period is from September 1, 2004 to December 31, 2010. (C-08-0557)
- H. An amendment to a contract between Lancaster County, on behalf of the Community Mental Health Center, and the Board of Regents of the University of Nebraska, found at County Contract No. C-07-0490, for the County providing clinical supervision, technical assistance, evaluation referrals, and office space to two Clinical Assessment Technicians provided by the University. The University will pay the County up to \$9,000 per year for the services. The amendment changes the end date of the term of the agreement from April 30, 2008 to April 30, 2009. (C-08-0558)
- An agreement with Cynthia D. Petersen for professional services of a nurse practitioner to assist in the provision of psychiatric services at the Community Mental Health Center. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2008 through June 30, 2009. The County will pay \$60 per hour for no more than eight hours per week. A business associate agreement is also attached to the agreement to comply with Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) Regulations. (C-08-0559)
- J. An agreement between Lancaster County, on behalf of Lancaster Manor, and BryanLGH Medical Center. The agreement secures discounted rates for Lancaster Manor residents who receive outpatient services at BryanLGH Hospital. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2008 to September 30, 2012. (C-08-0560)
