Dennis Meyer, Budget and Fiscal Officer, reviewed the resolution and indicated a change was made in the first paragraph on page one: Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-501 to 13-522 (Reissue 1997 & 2000 Cum. Supp.) was changed to Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 13-501 to 13-522 (Reissue 1997 & 2006 Cum. Supp.). He referred to Attachment A of the resolution noting that it reflects the following changes from the proposed budget to set the tax rate at 26.83 cents per \$100 of valuation:

- a) Reduce Debt Service Fund Expenditures Budget (5,057,483)
- b) Reduce Deb Service Fund Revenues Budget (1,454,000)
- c) Reduce Property Tax (3,603,483)
- d) Reduce two percent Reserve for Delinquent Taxes (72,069) (5,129,552)

The addendum contains language required by changes to applicable Nebraska Division of Medicaid and Long Term Care requirements and amends the contract to account for NMMCP's recent increase in reimbursement rates for medically necessary mental health services. Magellan will reimburse the County as provided in the new Exhibit B-1, effective July 1, 2008. (C-08-0444)
