- D. An interlocal agreement between the City of Waverly and Lancaster County to equally divide routine road maintenance responsibilities and implement a balance of services to better coordinate equipment routing for snow removal, mowing, grading, signage and paint striping along specific roads as show in Attachment A. The agreement supercedes and replaces the interlocal agreement, found under County Contract No. 98-2270, approved September 22, 1998. (C-09-0028)
- E. An amendment to a grant contract, under County Contract No. C-07-0043, between Lancaster County and El Centro de Las Americas for funding the community-driven initiatives to address violence against women among diverse and traditionally under-served populations. The amendment changes the ending date of the grant contract from August 31, 2008 to January 31, 2009. The extension is within the federal grant ending date. (C-09-0029)

An amendment to a unit price construction contract between Lancaster County and Schmader Electric Construction, found at County Contract Number C-08-0042, for the repair and maintenance of emergency management sirens in the County.
