An agreement between the County and Clark Enersen Partners for providing professional engineering services regarding mitigating the risk of damage to equipment in the event of a water line break at Lancaster Manor. The project shall be completed by April 1, 2009 and will cost the County up to \$3,200, plus expenses not to exceed \$100. (C-09-0090)
- H. An agreement between the Capital Humane Society (Contractor) and Lancaster County (County) for the performance of animal control related services in Lancaster County. The Contractor shall perform services related to the treatment and control of rabies, control of dogs running at large as the designated County Poundmaster, removal of the remains of certain animals from County roads, and other related services. The County will reimburse the Contractor in accordance with Appendix A to the agreement. (C-09-0091)
- A program agreement between the County and the Nebraska Department of Roads, for bridge replacement, Project No. RUR-3290(2), Hickman Northeast. The cost to the County is 20% of the estimated project cost or \$152,000. (C-09-0092)
