- H. An agreement between Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Election Commissioner, and Steve McClatchey for the delivery of voting machines and other miscellaneous equipment to several polling locations for the General Election on May 5, 2009. The agreement shall commence upon execution by both parties and shall continue until May 8, 2009. The County will pay \$48 per polling location for the delivery services. (C-09-0135)

- I. An agreement with Legacy International, Inc. d/b/a Legacy Inmate Communications for Inmate Phone Services at all three County Correctional Facilities. The term of the contract is for two years from the date of execution. The County will be paid a commission equal to 60% of the Gross Revenues generated by the phone services, with a guaranteed annual minimum commission of \$170,000. The County will also be paid a signing bonus of \$20,000 within 30 days from the date services are established. - J. A unit price construction contract with Commonwealth Electric Company of the Midwest for emergency and large project electrical services (under \$25,000).
