- G. A contract between Logan Contractors Supply, Inc., and Lancaster County for the annual supply of rubberized asphalt joint sealant. Term of the contract is one year from the date of execution of the contract. The County will pay for products according to the pricing as listed in the contractor's proposal. (C-09-0323)
- H. An agreement with the Lancaster County Medical Society (LCMS) to enroll qualified Lancaster County General Assistance clients in national pharmaceutical discount programs and to provide related services, including medical record development, and the training of General Assistance caseworkers. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2012. The County will reimburse LCMS based upon the established rates for each discount program and \$2,200 per month for related services. (C-09-0324)
- I. An agreement with South Lincoln Dermatology to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and South Lincoln Dermatology will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30-day termination provision. (C-09-0325)
- J. An agreement with Dr. Keith Reichmuth to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Dr. Keith Reichmuth will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30-day termination provision. (C-09-0326)
- K. An agreement with Midwest Storage Solutions, Inc., for storage space for the County Court Office addition hall and court office. The agreement shall begin at the time of execution of the contract and the services shall be completed by September 1, 2009. The County shall pay for the services according to the pricing as listed in the contractor's proposal. (C-09-0327)

- L. An interlocal agreement with the State of Nebraska Probation Administration for two probation officers to provide additional pre-sentence investigation report services to decrease the time needed to complete pre-sentence investigations of inmates housed by the Lancaster County Corrections Department. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2008, to June 30, 2009. The County will pay \$46,397.64 for the services. (C-09-0328)
- M. An amendment to an agreement with Nebraska Occupational Health Center, found at County Contract Number C-07-0298, to conduct post offer physical examinations and screenings of potential employees for Lancaster Manor. The amendment renews the contract for an additional one-year term beginning July 1, 2009, and ending June 30, 2010. (C-09-0329)
- N. A grant contract between the Board of Trustees of the Community Health Endowment and Lancaster County on behalf of the Community Mental Health Center to collect and analyze consumer data related to the behavioral Health Jail Diversion Project. The County shall receive \$5,000 for the services. The term of the contract is from July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010. (C-09-0330)
- O. A sub-grant award agreement for 2009 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) No 2009-EP-E9-0058, with the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) as the grantee and Lancaster County Emergency Management as the sub-grantee. The sub-grant is in the amount of \$65,940 and covers the period from June 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010. (C-09-0331)
- P. A sub-grant extra award agreement for 2008 Emergency Management Performance Grant (EMPG) No 2008-EM-E8-0032, with the Nebraska Emergency Management Agency (NEMA) as the grantee and Lancaster County Emergency Management as the sub-grantee. The sub-grant is in the amount of \$33,747.53 and covers the period from October 1, 2007, through September 30, 2009. (C-09-0332)
- Q. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Crime Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for the Talented Tenth Scholar's Program grant. The County will receive \$32,000 of which \$14,750 is the County's match share. Term of the grant award is July 1, 2009, to June 30, 2010.
