- L. An interlocal agreement between Lancaster County and Educational Services Unit No. 18 for educational services to youth detained at the Youth Services Center. Term of the agreement is August 1, 2009, through July 31, 2010. The County will reimburse the ESU up to \$998,800 for the services provided. (C-09-0360)
- M. An amendment to a cooperative purchasing agreement between Lancaster County, the City of Lincoln and Shredding Solutions for document shredding services for County departments.
