Term of the memorandum of understanding is for three years from the date of execution or until the ending date of the 2008 FY Disabilities Grant, whichever is sooner. - G. An interlocal agreement with the City of Lincoln for left turn lanes to be added on Van Dorn Street at S. 91st Street and on Pioneers Boulevard at Thorn Court with no cost to the County. (C-09-0513)

- H. An agreement with First Choice Vending for vending services at correctional facilities. The term of the agreement is from the date of execution to February 1, 2012. The County will be paid 21% of the gross revenues and is guaranteed a \$25,000 annual minimum commission. The County also will be paid a \$10,000 signing bonus. (C-09-0514)
- I. An agreement with Mike's 66 and Towing for towing and storage of towed vehicles for the Lancaster County Sheriff's office. The term of the agreement is three years from the date of execution. The County will pay for the services pursuant to the pricing provided in the Contractor's proposal. (C-09-0515)
- J. An agreement between Lancaster County and the Child Advocacy Center to conduct interviews and medical examinations of child abuse victims to aid law enforcement and prosecution in their investigations of child abuse. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010, and the County will pay \$20,000 for the services. (C-09-0516)
- K. Approval of an assignment, assumption and amendment agreement between Wells Fargo Brokerage Services, L.L.C., and Wachovia Bank, National Association. The agreement assigns the rights and duties of Wells Fargo Brokerage Services, L.L.C., to Wachovia Bank, National Association under a remarketing agreement involving \$6,500,000 worth of industrial development bonds authorized by Lancaster County under Lancaster County Resolution No. R-00-131. (C-09-0517)
- L. An agreement between the Nebraska Department of Health and Human Services Division of Children and Family Services and Lancaster County Youth Services Center for the provision of detention services for youth committed to or placed with the State's Office of Juvenile Services. The County will be paid \$236 per youth per day. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2009, through September 30, 2010. (C-09-0520)
- M. A grant contract with Cedars Youth Services to provide funding for the Centralized Risk/Needs Assessment Project in the amount of \$56,378. Cedars will contribute \$9,177 in matching funds. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. (C-09-0521)
- A grant contract with Cedars Youth Services for the Skills and Asset Building in Juvenile Justice Program in the amount of \$15,000. Cedars will contribute \$15,000 in matching funds. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010. (C-09-0522)
- O. An addendum to a contract with Helget, Inc., d/b/a Capital Medical, for respiratory and related services at Lancaster Manor found at County Contract No. C-03-0429. The addendum extends the term of the contract for an additional six months, ending February 28, 2010. (C-09-0523)

The amendment increases the monthly payment for services from \$6,750 to \$6,972.75 from July 1, 2009, through December 31, 2009. (C-09-0525)

An amendment to the professional services agreement between The Clark Enersen Partners and Lancaster County for architectural design and engineering services for the new adult detention facility found at County Contract No. C-08-0055. The amendment provides for compensation for additional services, including providing additional civil engineering services for a new entrance to the new jail from West O Street and the executive order work required for the West O Street revisions. The cost of the additional services shall not exceed \$40,675. (C-09-0526)
- S. A quitclaim deed from Lancaster County as grantor and Daryl Meyer as grantee for a portion of a vacated alley adjacent to Lot 5, Block 7, Village of Sprague, Lancaster County, Nebraska, and the grant of a permanent easement from Lancaster County as grantor to Daryl Meyer as grantee for the purpose of allowing a portion of a concrete slab to remain on Lot 1, Block 7, Village of Sprague, Lancaster County, Nebraska. The grantee will pay the grantor \$40 for the quitclaim deed and \$20 for the permanent easement.
