- D. A utility relocation agreement between Lancaster County and Norris Public Power District, in the amount of \$53,275.49, to relocate utility facilities to accommodate the grading of Bluff Road between N. 148th Street and N. 190th Street; Project No. C55-H-402(1). (C-10-0046)
