- A. # 4) **NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:**

- C. A contract with Dry Clean City for the annual requirements of uniform dry cleaning for the County Sheriff and County Corrections. Cost of the services shall be according to the pricing listed in the contractor's proposal. Services shall be provided on an as needed basis. Term of the contract is four years from the date of execution. (C-10-0377)
- D. An agreement with the University of Nebraska, Board of Regents and the Lincoln Housing Authority for operation of the Nutrition Education Program to address the nutritional needs of certain limited income persons living in urban housing in Lancaster County. The County will pay \$23,372 for the services which will be provided by the University. The Housing Authority will pay \$10,519 for the services, combined with \$5,736 from the United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Food Stamp Nutrition Education grant, for a total of \$39,627. Term of the agreement is September 1, 2010, to August 31, 2011. (C-10-0376)
- E. An agreement with the State of Nebraska, Department of Education for the National School Lunch Program and related programs at the Lancaster County Youth Services Center. (C-10-0374)
- F. An amendment to an assistance agreement between the U.S. Department of Energy and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Adult Correctional Facility, found at County Contract No. C-10-0188, for a grant in the amount of \$110,300, which will fund the development of an energy efficiency and conservation strategy. The amendment replaces the terms and conditions, updates the project activity worksheets, replaces the reporting requirements, adds wage determination and approved strategy and provides notification that project activities are approved by the National Environmental Protection Agency (NEPA). (C-10-0375)
- G. An agreement with L.A. Young, Inc., for professional services of a nurse practitioner to assist in the provision of psychiatric services at the Community Mental Health Center. The County will pay \$65 per hour for no more than 40 hours per week. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. A business associate agreement is attached to the agreement to comply with Health Insurance Portability & Accountability Act (HIPAA) regulations. (C-10-0372)
- H. Approval of a Medicare enrollment application for the reassignment of Medicare benefits to the Lancaster County Community Mental Health Center and authorization for Commissioner Bob Workman to sign the application. The application allows Mary E. Sullivan to reassign her right to bill the Medicare program and receive Medicare payments to the Community Mental Health Center. (C-10-0373)
- I. Acceptance of a grant award from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice for the TeamMates Project MOAST. The County will receive \$7,500 in grant funds and TeamMates will provide \$14,574 in matching funds for a total project cost of \$22,074. Term of the grant award is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011.
- J. Appointment of Andrew Weeks as Deputy Public Defender at an annual salary of \$58,473, effective July 20, 2010.

- K. Creation of County Rule 21 of the Personnel rules Furlough.
- L. Memorandum of agreement between the Lincoln Council on Alcoholism and Drugs, Inc., and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office, for the purpose of providing a Sheriff Deputy to act as a liaison between the Prevention Leadership Team and the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office to prevent underage drinking and alcohol related automobile accidents in Lancaster County. - M. An agreement with Blue Cross and Blue Shield of Nebraska to provide administrative services for the early retiree reinsurance program. Term of the contract is from the date of execution until January 1, 2014. There is no cost to the county. (C-10-0379)
