- D. An amendment to an agreement between A to Z Printing, the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County and the Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission, found at County Contract No. C-08-0364, for the annual requirements of envelope supply and printing. The amendment provides for price increases pursuant to Attachment 1. (C-10-0541)
- E. A contract between M & M Used Oil Services, Inc., the City of Lincoln and Lancaster County for the annual supply of used oil collection. The County will pay for items pursuant to State of Nebraska Contract No. QG1008. Term of the contract is October 1, 2010, to March 31, 2011. (C-10-0547)
- F. An agreement between the City of Lincoln, on behalf of the Lincoln-Lancaster County Planning Department, Lincoln Electric System (LES) and the City of Lincoln Public Works Department, and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Engineering Department, to provide for the funding of Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc., for professional services onsite consulting support and Geographic Information System (GIS) enhancement planning. The County shall pay up to \$9,000 for the services provided. Term of the agreement is one year from the date of execution by both parties. (C-10-0542)

An agreement between Lancaster County, Region V Systems and Cornhusker Place of Lincoln-Lancaster County, Inc., for Cornhusker Place to assist the County and Region V by including in the services it presently provides the detention of individuals who are in Emergency Protective Custody (EPC) in cases in which detention at Cornhusker Place is appropriate. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. Any party may terminate the agreement by giving 60 days written notice. (C-10-0543)
- H. An agreement between Lancaster County and the Mental Health Association for a Supported Employment/Education Special Assistant to carry out duties and conduct research for the Community Mental Health Center's participation in the "Recovery After the Initial Schizophrenia Episode (RAISE)" project. The County shall pay \$24.03 per hour for no more than five hours of service per week. Term of the agreement is May 1, 2010, to July 12, 2011. (C-10-0544)
- A grant contract with CASA for Lancaster County in the amount of \$25,000 to provide funding for the court appointed advocates program. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. (C-10-0545)
- J. A grant contract with the Lincoln Council on Alcoholism & Drugs in the amount of \$25,000 to provide funding for the substance abuse prevention program. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. (C-10-0546)
- K. A grant contract with the Lincoln Council on Alcoholism & Drugs in the amount of \$196,000 to provide implementation funding for the Lancaster Alcohol and Abuse Prevention Partnership. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2010, to September 30, 2011. (C-10-0548)
- L. A grant contract with Heartland Big Brothers Big Sisters in the amount of \$25,000 to provide funding for the Heartland Big Brothers Big Sisters program. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. (C-10-0549)
