- F. A contract between Lancaster County and Region V Systems for funding of capacity building efforts in Lancaster County. Region V Systems shall pay the County \$50,000 for the services provided. Term of the contract is July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. (C-10-0632)
- G. An amendment to County Contract No. C-08-0219 with Legal Aid of Nebraska for legal representation of indigent parties in proceedings in the Juvenile Court of Lancaster County. The amendment increases the monthly payment for services from \$23,365.22 to \$24,136.27 from July 1, 2010, to June 30, 2011. (C-10-0633)
