- O. A detention services agreement with Kearney County for juvenile services. Lancaster County will provide for the safekeeping, care and sustenance of juveniles while at the Youth Services Center. Kearney County will pay Lancaster County a rate of \$236 per youth per day. The agreement is effective upon execution by both parties. (C-11-0437)
- P. Acceptance of assignment of services from the Nebraska Heart Institute to Nebraska Specialty Network, LLC for the services outlined in County Contract No. C-06-0173. The services to be provided are specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits.
