An amendment to County Contract C-09-0426 between Electronic Disposal Technologies, Inc., Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln for recycling services of broken, end of life or outdated electronic equipment. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2011, to June 30, 2012. (C-11-0609)

An agreement with Gynecologic Surgeons & Obstetricians, PC, to provide specialized medical care and assistance to Lancaster County General Assistance clients who have pending claims with the Social Security Administration and may be eligible for retroactive Medicaid benefits. The agreement sets forth a reimbursement arrangement in which the County will provide payment for the medical care and Gynecologic Surgeons & Obstetricians, PC, will reimburse the County if/when the General Assistance client is later determined eligible for Medicaid reimbursement. The agreement is effective upon execution of both parties and contains a 30-day termination provision. (C-11-0610)
