The location announcement of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was given and the meeting was called to order at 9:30 a.m.

1) <u>MINUTES</u>: Approval of the minutes of the Board of Commissioners meeting and the minutes of the County budget public hearing both held on Tuesday, August 30, 2011.

MOTION: Raybould moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the minutes. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

2) <u>CLAIMS:</u> Approval of all claims processed through Tuesday, September 6, 2011.

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the claims. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

3) **SPECIAL PRESENTATIONS:**

A. Ceremonial administration of the oath of office to Dave Shively, Lancaster County Election Commissioner, and Maura Kelly Tolzin, Chief Deputy Lancaster County Election Commissioner.

Per Schorr's request, Dave Shively gave an overview of his and Maura Kelly Tolzin's history with the Election Commission.

The Clerk administered the oath to Shively and Kelly Tolzin.

4) **NEW BUSINESS**:

A. An interlocal agreement with the City of Hickman for the provision of law enforcement services with the City, as needed by the City. The Sheriff shall assign one Deputy for duty and provide one Sheriff's cruiser. The County shall be reimbursed at the Deputy's overtime rate for the services provided and shall be reimbursed \$0.555 per mile for cruiser maintenance. Total compensation to the County shall not exceed \$3,500. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2011, to September 30, 2012. (C-11-0499)

Terry Wagner, County Sheriff, said this item corresponds with the standard agreement in Item 4B, which has been in place over 20 years and provides one full time Deputy Sheriff to Hickman. He said this "as needed" agreement covers overtime worked in Hickman; the overtime is paid back to the County plus mileage.

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the agreement. Heier, Smoyer, Raybould and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

B. An interlocal agreement with the City of Hickman for one Sheriff's Deputy for law enforcement services within the corporate limits of the City of Hickman. The County will be reimbursed up to \$86,350.58. Term of the agreement is October 1, 2011, to September 30, 2012. (C-11-0500)

MOTION: Raybould moved and Heier seconded approval of the agreement. Smoyer, Raybould, Heier and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

C. An interlocal agreement between Lancaster County and the City of Lincoln to provide assistance with Pandemic Flu Preparedness and Response and continuity of operations planning. The City will pay the County \$10,000 for the services of the Deputy Lancaster County Emergency Management Director. Term of the contract is July 1, 2011 to December 31, 2011. (C-11-0501)

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the agreement. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

D. An agreement with the Lincoln Council on Alcoholism and Drugs, Inc., to provide substance use evaluation services for Community Corrections. The County will pay up to \$125 per participant should the participant not pay within 30 days. Term of the contract is July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. (C-11-0502)

MOTION: Raybould moved and Heier seconded approval of the agreement. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

E. An amendment to County Contract No. C-10-0021 between Mid-Continent Safety LLC, the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County and the Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission for the annual supply of personal protective equipment and first aid supplies. The amendment provides for the addition of the line items listed in Attachment A. (C-11-0503)

NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the amendment. Heier, Smoyer, Raybould and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

F. An amendment to County Contract No. C-09-0564 with Waste Connections of Nebraska, for waste hauling services. The amendment provides for a 3% price increase in accordance with Attachment A, and renews the agreement for an additional two-year term from November 1, 2011 to October 31, 2013. (C-11-0504)

Schorr noted the 3% increase is a fuel surcharge contingent upon the price of fuel exceeding \$3.11 per gallon.

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the amendment. Smoyer, Raybould, Heier and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

G. A grant contract with Regional Behavioral Health Authority to provide funding for an online resource library for non-profit agencies in Lancaster County. The grant amount is \$25,000 and the term of the grant contract is July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. (C-11-0505)

MOTION: Smoyer moved and Heier seconded approval of the contract. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

H. A grant contract with Voices of Hope to provide funding for the Project Coordinator of the program, "A Coordinated Response to Reducing Domestic Violence." The County will expend federal grant funds in an amount of \$43,722. Term of the grant contract is June 1, 2011 to May 31, 2012. (C-11-0511)

MOTION: Raybould moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the contract. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

A resolution in the matter of the vacation of a portion of West Panama Road a.k.a Lot
located at a point in the Southwest Quarter of Section 4, Township 7 North, Range

J. A resolution in the matter of approving the Lancaster County Fiscal Budget for the Fiscal Year of July 1, 2011 to June 30, 2012. (R-11-0066)

Raybould thanked County employees, department directors and elected officials for their part in the budget process. She discussed ongoing and future budget challenges.

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the resolution. Smoyer, Raybould, Heier and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

K. A political subdivision tort claim filed against Lancaster County by Dukhan Mumin for alleged violations of state and federal speedy trial requirements.

Brittany Behrens, Deputy County Attorney, said this tort claim was filed in response to a previously denied tort claim. She recommended denial.

MOTION: Heier moved and Smoyer seconded denial of the tort claim based on the County Attorney's recommendation. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.
