C. A resolution in the matter of vacating a portion of NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street between W. Branched Oak Road and W. Raymond Road, such portion beginning at a point 575 feet north of the Southwest corner of the Northwest quarter, Section 34, Township 12 North, Range 6 East of the 6<sup>th</sup> Principal Meridian, thence north ending at a point 775 feet north of said Southwest corner of said Northwest quarter, Lancaster County, Nebraska. D. A resolution in the matter of closing a portion of NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street between W. Raymond Road and W. Branched Oak Road, authorizing installation of a fence, gates and barriers on said portion of NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street and closing the bridge on the portion of NW 12<sup>th</sup> Street between W. Branched Oak Road and W. Raymond Road in Lancaster County. (R-11-0095)

E. A utility relocation agreement between Lancaster County and Lancaster Rural Water District No. 1 of Bennet, Nebraska, in an estimated amount of \$185,814.80, to relocate water lines for a grading project on Pine Lake Road from S. 112<sup>th</sup> Street to S. 148<sup>th</sup> Street; Project C55-Q-409(1). (C-11-0717)

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Raybould seconded approval of the agreement. Heier, Smoyer, Raybould and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

F. An amended federal equitable sharing agreement and annual certification report for the Lancaster County Attorney's Office regarding equitable sharing activity of drug forfeiture funds for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2010. The amended form corrects a duplicate entry of \$8,320.74. (C-11-0718)

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Raybould seconded approval of the agreement and report. Smoyer, Raybould, Heier and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

G. A memorandum of understanding between the City of Hickman and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office, for the design, construction and maintenance of a memorial for fallen police officers. The memorial will be located at Lot 4 of Old School House Addition, Hickman, Lancaster County, Nebraska. (C-11-0723)

Terry Wagner, County Sheriff, said Deputy Sheriff Craig Dodge was shot and killed at this location on March 14, 1987. The land will be deeded to the City of Hickman, and the memorandum of understanding will allow the memorial to be built on that property. Wagner noted there are no tax dollars involved and several donations have already been received.

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Raybould seconded approval of the memorandum of understanding. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

### NEW BUSINESS CONTINUED:

H. A contract between Eletech, Inc., Lancaster County, the City of Lincoln and the Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission for elevator service, maintenance and testing. The County will pay for products and services according to the pricing as provided in the contractor's proposal. Term of the contract is January 1, 2012, to December 31, 2015. (C-11-0724)

Raybould commended Bob Walla and the Purchasing Department for evaluating the service provider agreements. As a result, the County will save around \$6,000 per month in service maintenance.

**MOTION:** Raybould moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the contract. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

1. An agreement with Tyler Technologies, Inc., in the amount of \$36,500 for property assessment field data collection software used by the County Assessor/Register of Deeds Office. The agreement is effective upon execution and will continue through June 30, 2012. (C-11-0725)

**MOTION:** Raybould moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the agreement. Heier, Smoyer, Raybould and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

J. An agreement with CenterPointe for the purpose of defining the responsibilities of the parties in funding roof repair at 2220 S. 10<sup>th</sup> Street. Total cost of the repair is \$33,031. CenterPointe will pay \$14,452.62 and Lancaster County will pay \$18,578.38 for the repair. (C-11-0726)

Item was held per request of the County Attorney.

K. Approval of a Medicare enrollment application for the reassignment of Medicare benefits to the Lancaster County Community Mental Health Center and authorization for Commissioner Bernie Heier to sign the application. The application allows Kathy L. Foster to reassign her right to bill the Medicare program and receive Medicare payments to the Community Mental Health Center. (C-11-0727)

**MOTION:** Raybould moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the application. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

L. Addendum to County Contract C-04-0009 with Ameritas Investment Corp for financial consulting services with respect to financing debt of Lancaster County. The addendum renews the contract for a four-year term and re-designates the representatives in charge of administering the agreement. (C-11-0728)

**MOTION:** Raybould moved and Heier seconded approval of the addendum. Raybould, Heier, Smoyer and Schorr voted aye. Hudkins was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

M. A political subdivision tort claim filed against Lancaster County Corrections by Gerald L. Andersen for lost property in the amount of \$500.
