The County shall pay for products according to the pricing as listed in the contractor's proposal on an as needed basis. Term of the contract is one year from the date of execution by both parties. An agreement with Great Plains Appraisal Company, on behalf of Wayne Kubert and Tom Kubert, to provide the services of a Referee Coordinator to coordinate referees who will hear all property tax protests for the 2012 tax year before the Lancaster County Board of Equalization. The coordinator is also responsible for ensuring all papers related to such protests along with written findings and recommendations are made available to the Board. The Referee Coordinator shall be reimbursed at a rate of \$720 per working day up to \$180,000. (C-12-0239)
- I. A renewal of a maintenance agreement with Environmental Systems Research Institute, Inc. (ESRI) in the amount of \$16,000 for ArcGIS software used by the Lancaster County Engineer and County Assessor/Register of Deeds Geographic Information System (GIS). Term of the agreement is July 21, 2012, to July 20, 2013. (C-12-0240)

A memorandum of understanding between Region V Systems and Lancaster County for the purpose of defining the duties and responsibilities of Region V and the County in the development of a new service model for the provision of integrated primary care and community behavioral health services in Lancaster County.
