- K. A grant contract with Cedars Youth Services, Inc., in the amount of \$130,000 per year to provide funding for Cedars' Tracking Program. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2012, to June 30, 2015. (C-12-0334)
- L. A grant contract with Cedars Youth Services, Inc., in the amount of \$290,000 per year to provide funding for the Out of Home Continuum program. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2012, to June 30, 2015. (C-12-0335)

An agreement with the University of Nebraska Board of Regents, on behalf of the Clinical Psychology Training Program, for five graduate psychology students who will provide services such as psychotherapy, counseling and psychological testing for the Community Mental Health Center. The County will pay \$82,924.80 for the services. Term of the agreement is June 1, 2012, to May 31, 2013. (C-12-0339)
- Q. A child and adult care food program application and agreement with Nebraska Department of Education, Nutrition Services for Program Year 2013 on behalf of the Lancaster County Community Mental Health Center. (C-12-0340)
