B. Interlocal agreement with the Village of Denton for law enforcement services within the Village limits. The Lancaster County Sheriff will assign one deputy to duty in the Village limits and provide a cruiser. The Village will reimburse the County at the overtime rate of pay for the Deputy assigned. Term of the agreement will be from September 1, 2013, to August 31, 2014. (C-13-0391)

Terry Wagner, County Sheriff, said the part time agreements have been in force with Denton, as well as Firth and Hallam, for close to 20 years. He noted these deputies are bike certified so they can go on the area trails. Schorr and Raybould commended the Sheriff's department for consolidating the law enforcement for the best use of tax dollars. Wagner agreed and said the budgets would be almost double if the villages had to provide their own law enforcement.
