The Chair noted the location of the Open Meetings Act and opened the meeting at 8:30 a.m.

#### **AGENDA ITEM**

1 APPROVAL OF THE STAFF MEETING MINUTES OF THURSDAY, APRIL 18, 2013

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Raybould seconded approval of the minutes of the

April 18, 2013 Staff Meeting. Smoyer, Raybould and Hudkins voted aye.

Amundson abstained from voting. Schorr was absent from voting.

Motion carried 3-0, with one abstention.

#### 2 ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

None were stated.

**3 LEGISLATIVE UPDATE** - Gordon Kissel and Joe Kohout, Kissel/E&S Associates (Legislative Consultant)

Joe Kohout, Kissel/E&S Associates, presented a legislative update and a bills of interest report (Exhibits A and B), noting the next major benchmark will be May 1st when the Appropriations Committee bill will be advanced to the full Legislature for consideration. He noted there is roughly \$37,000,000 in discretionary spending left in the budget.

Discussion took place regarding Legislative Bill (LB) 561 (State findings and intent for changes to the juvenile justice system and a funding mechanism). Kohout said an amendment will likely be offered on Select File to decrease the \$10,000,000 appropriation down to \$7,000,000 the first year and \$6,000,000 the second year. He said he is working with Larry Dix, Nebraska Association of County Officials (NACO) Executive Director, on language to address the 10-day provision (the requirement that the State is responsible for costs after 10 days when a youth in custody is sent out for evaluation has been deleted from the latest version of the bill). Kerry Eagan, Chief Administrative Officer, said failing that, it is important to limit the time to complete the evaluation to 21 days.

Hudkins said Jim Blue, Cedars Youth Services Executive Director, informed Juvenile Court Judge Heideman the Department of Health and Human Services (DHHS) has reduced Cedars funding by 14% and it will no longer be able to accept male boarding contracts.

Raybould asked how much is budgeted for juvenile justice programs. Sheli Schindler, Youth Services Center (YSC) Director, appeared and said it is approximately \$1,500,000, explaining the funding formula is based on population. She added there are concerns that LB 561 only reflects funding for the next two years. Joe Kelly, County Attorney, appeared and added that the bill shows youth rehabilitation and treatment facilities in Geneva and Kearney closing in 2015. Raybould said she thought the intent was to modify those facilities for this new model. Kelly said that has been discussed, as well as reducing them to small lock-down facilities.

Schindler predicted that if LB 561 passes, the County Attorney, Public Defender, Courts, etc. will have an increased workload and youth will have longer lengths of stay in YSC. She said there will also be an increased push for alternatives, which has been a County expense.

#### **ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REPORT**

A. City-County Common Agenda Items (May 7, 2013)

It was noted there are no agenda items and the City Council Chair has suggested that the meeting be cancelled. The Board concurred with the suggestion.

B. Community Mental Health Center (CMHC) Office Furniture

Eagan asked whether the Board wants to allow County departments to look at what office furniture might be available for County purposes. Board consensus was to give the Crisis Center's needs priority.

#### **ACTION ITEMS**

A. Mini-Grant Application for Litter Removal on County Roads

**MOTION:** Amundson moved and Smoyer seconded approval, with signature by the Chair. Raybould, Smoyer, Amundson and Hudkins voted aye. Schorr was absent from voting. Motion carried 4-0.

4 CASE MANAGEMENT CONTRACT WITH LIZ NEELEY, DOING BUSINESS AS (DBA) OBJECTIVE ADVANTAGE - Joe Kelly, Lancaster County Attorney; Liz Neeley, DBA Objective Advantage,

Joe Kelly, Lancaster County Attorney, discussed a proposed agreement with Liz Neeley, DBA Objective Advantage, for professional consulting services to establish caseload standards for the County Attorney's Office. He noted that Neeley has provided similar services to the Public Defender's Office. Neeley said the information can be used to make informed workload and caseload decisions, track quality issues and answer policy questions. Kelly said the contract will be funded with drug forfeiture funds, so there will be no cost to the County.

Board consensus was to schedule the contract on the April 30, 2013 County Board of Commissioners Meeting agenda.

#### **RETURNING TO ITEM 8B**

Hudkins said it is the Board's intent to make CMHC's office furniture and computers available to the Crisis Center and the new provider(s). C. J. Johnson, Region V Systems Administrator, appeared and said he supports that plan. He noted 29 of CMHC's computers were purchased through the Electronic Behavioral Health Information Network (eBHIN) and felt any remaining after the Crisis Center has selected what they need should be returned to eBHIN to be redistributed.

Johnson indicated that responses to the Request for Proposal (RFP) for community behavioral health services are due on April 26<sup>th</sup> and said the RFP Review Committee will make its recommendations by May 10<sup>th</sup>. He said he went outside the Region V area to select consumers to serve on the RFP Review Committee to avoid the appearance of a conflict of interest.

5 LANCASTER COUNTY RURAL BUSINESS ADDRESS COMMITTEE REPORT - Members of the Lancaster County Rural Business Address Committee (Tara Garza; Terry Kathe; Arlynn Brunke; Doug Pillard; Brittany Behrens; John Watson; and Kerry Eagan)

Eagan noted 911/Emergency Services brought a public safety issue to the attention of the County Board in February. A Sheriff's Deputy had been dispatched to a business

on Saltillo Road but was unable to locate the property in question. The business was located on a long private drive serving multiple businesses with a range of addresses. There were no address signs posted at either the entrance to the private drive or the individual businesses. Since the lack of address signs for rural businesses is a countywide safety issue, the Board organized a committee to make recommendations regarding a policy governing business addresses. **NOTE:** The County reviewed rural residential addresses in 1999 and corrected a number of addresses for public safety purposes. Business addresses were not addressed at that time. The County Board decided to post uniform blue address signs in the County-owned right-of-way for each occupied rural residential parcel. Blue address signs were also posted at the entrance to private driveways serving multiple addresses but were not posted in front of each individual residence along the private drive. That has also caused difficulties for emergency responders.

The Lancaster County Rural Business Address Committee's recommendations are as follows:

- Address signs should be posted on County roads for all businesses which are included in the County's address database:
  - Standards should be developed for the purpose of classifying which land uses should be included as a business for purposes of posting address signs.
  - ► Inaccurate business addresses should be corrected following the same procedure under which inaccurate residential addresses were corrected.
- The Lancaster County Board should pass a resolution requiring all occupied residential properties and all business properties to have address signs which meet County standards:
  - Residences and businesses located on private drives serving multiple properties should be required to provide the address sign at their own cost.
- The County should develop a strategy, with a funding plan, for replacement of worn out address signs located on County roads. Responsibility for sign placement should be placed with the County Engineer's Office.
- The County should work with the villages and cities in the County to implement these recommendations within their extra territorial zoning jurisdictions.

Eagan said County Engineering has estimated there are 120 rural businesses that do not have signs, noting 10 do not meet geocoding standards. He said a replacement strategy for the signage is also needed, as they fade and lose reflectivity over time. **NOTE:** The County initially paid for the signage for rural residences out of the Keno Fund. Eagan said it is proposed that any of the signs that are posted in the right-of-way will be at County expense. That gives the County control of color, style and placement.

Hudkins asked whether the County Engineer's sign shop could produce the replacement signage. Doug Pillard, County Engineering, said it can, provided it is on a small volume basis. A large volume would have to be contracted out.

MOTION: Smoyer moved and Amundson seconded to accept the recommendations and direct the County Attorney's Office to prepare a resolution to amend the County Zoning Regulations to include the new requirements. Smoyer, Amundson, Raybould and Hudkins voted aye. Schorr was absent from voting. Motion carried 4-0.



Weekly Update on the 2013 Legislature

Please accept this as the eleventh weekly report for the 2013 Legislative Session. Today is the sixty-seventh day of the 90-day session. This week has seen the movement of a significant amount of legislation both off of General and Select File. A significant amount of the day on Monday was spent debating LB407, the state aid to school bill.

As far as timelines go, the next major benchmark comes next Wednesday at the 70<sup>th</sup> day when budget will need to be released.

#### LANCASTER COUNTY PRIORITIES:

- 1. Oppose Elimination of the inheritance tax. As we have reported previously no bills were introduced to eliminate the inheritance tax. Senator Wightman's LB600 the bill that would lower rates of taxation was heard on Wednesday, February 27, 2013 before the Revenue Committee and Chairman Hudkins testified in opposition. The bill has not advanced and was not prioritized. We believe that there will be some component of review of the inheritance tax under the LB613 review.
- 2. Support Expansion of Medicaid under the Affordable Care Act. LB577 was debated on Monday and Tuesday of last week. The bill faced significant opposition on the floor of the Legislature. Concern about unintended cost and long term sustainability of the program were raised prior to and during debate. Ultimately, there were not the votes committed to invoking cloture over the opponent's filibuster. There continue to be meetings by the proponents in an effort to identify potential supporters and an effort to move the bill to Select File.
- 3. Eliminate Responsibility of Counties to Pay HHS Rent. LB632 was referred to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee and public hearing was held on Wednesday, March 6, 2013. Mr. Eagan appeared in support along with NACO.

- The Department appeared in opposition through Kerry Winterer. Senator Bolz is working with Senator Avery on a potential home for this bill.
- 4. Modify Right to Court Appointed Attorney in Juvenile Court. LB342 was referred to the Judiciary Committee and public hearing held on March 6, 2013. Liz Neely appeared on behalf of the county along with NACO. There was no opposition. We are pleased to report that the bill has been advanced by the Judiciary Committee. While the bill was not selected for consent calendar, Senator Coash has expressed a willingness to explore options for amending the bill onto another bill.
- 5. Definition and Oversight for Staff Secure Juvenile Detention Facilities. LB86 was referred to the Judiciary Committee and hearing held on March 7, 2013. Sheli Schindler appeared on behalf of the county along with NACO and Sarpy County. In the first amendment to LB561, the language from this bill was included. The most recent amendment to LB561 presented to us this week does continue to include the language from LB86.

#### OTHER LEGISLATION:

- 1. **LB63 (Schilz) Change distribution of certain sales and use tax revenue.** *NO POSITION.* Brent Meyer recommends that we support this legislation because it will provide additional funding for aquatic invasive plants. It diverts ½ of the sales tax and registrations fees from motorboats to create a special fund. It was heard on March 14, 2013 before the Revenue Committee and there was a significant amount of support with no opposition. We do not expect this bill to advance.
- 2. **LB123 (Lautenbaugh) Change distribution of indigent defense fees.** *OPPOSE.* This hearing was held on January 25, 2013 before the Judiciary Committee. This bill was indefinitely postponed by the Judiciary Committee.
- 3. **LB215 (Schilz) Change provisions relating to use of the County Visitors Promotion Fund.** *OPPOSE/NEUTRAL WITH AMENDMENT.* As previously reported, an amendment was offered to the committee during the hearing February 13, 2013 that addressed the concerns raised by Lancaster County. The bill has advanced with the amendment agreed to by Lancaster County. Please note that this bill was not prioritized but could be eligible for the Consent Calendar.
- 4. **LB284 (Conrad) Change provisions of the Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act relating to actions and amounts recoverable.** *OPPOSE.* Referred to the Judiciary Committee, the hearing was on February 13, 2013. Lancaster County submitted a letter in opposition to the bill. We expect the bill to advance from that committee but have not yet. Please note that this bill was not prioritized.
- 5. **LB317 (Price)** Change a duty of county assessors relating to real property valuation. *OPPOSE*. This bill was heard by the Revenue Committee on March 21, 2013 and both NACO and Douglas County appeared in opposition. Mr. Agena indicated during a previous meeting that he may need an additional 8 people and \$700,000 to comply with this legislation. This bill was not prioritized and has not been advanced by the Revenue Committee.



- 6. **LB348 (Harr) Change provisions relating to the assessment of certain rent-restricted housing projects.** *NO POSITION.* The hearing was held on March 1, 2013. As you will recall, we indicated that we would not oppose this legislation. The bill has advanced and was declared a speaker priority.
- 7. **LB381 (Janssen) Require photographic identification to vote.** *NO POSITION.* Introduced by Senator Charlie Janssen, the bill was referred to the Government Committee and hearing was held on March 7, 2013. Please note that this bill was not prioritized.
- 8. **LB483 (Bolz) Provide for a reentry planning program in adult correctional facilities.** *SUPPORT.* This measure was heard before the Judiciary Committee on Friday, February 22, 2013. A letter of support was submitted to the Committee. It has been declared a speaker priority and was debated this week and moved to Select File.
- 9. LB613 (Schumacher) Create the Tax Modernization Commission. NO POSITION.

  This bill was heard by the Executive Board of the Legislative Council on February 19, 2013. It was prioritized by Senator McCoy and will be amended to allow for the Revenue Committee chairman to serve as chair of that Committee. The bill has been the subject of a filibuster by Senator Chambers for several days and cloture was invoked yesterday. The study will move forward. An amendment has been filed by Senator Krist that would place a moratorium on both occupation taxes enacted by cities and on the additional one-half cent of sales tax that was passed last year. While Senator Krist is likely to withdraw that amendment, Senator Chambers has filed an amendment to this bill to repeal the additional half cent. The bill has not yet been debated on Select File.
- 10. **LB636 (Wallman) Provide restrictions for application of certain herbicides.**OPPOSE. This legislation was heard on March 5, 2013 before the Agriculture Committee. We do not expect this bill to move. Please note that this bill was not prioritized.
- 11. **LB246 (Larson) Provide for a health care copayment for jail and prison inmates.** *NO POSITION.* The hearing was held on February 7, 2013 before the Judiciary Committee. We do not expect this bill to move. Please note that this bill was not prioritized.
- 12. **LB531 (Conrad) Change distribution of sales and use tax revenue and repeal the Build Nebraska Act.** *NO POSITION.* The hearing was held on February 27, 2013 before the Revenue Committee with significant opposition. Please note that this bill was not prioritized.
- 13. LB561 (Ashford) State findings and intent for changes to the juvenile justice system and a funding mechanism. NO POSITION. The hearing on this bill was held on March 7, 2013 before the Judiciary Committee and is the Judiciary Committee priority bill. As previously mentioned, we have been working with Mr. Eagan, Ms. Thorpe and Ms. Schindler to develop concepts that would address Lancaster County's concerns with the original amendments thereto. The bill was debated on General File this week and was advanced to Select File after only a one-hour debate. One item is that Senator Ashford is likely to offer an amendment on Select File that will decrease the \$10 Million appropriation down to \$7 Million in the first year and



roughly \$6 Million in the second year. We are working with NACO on a potential amendment to address the 10-days of costs in detention.
