- I. Grant contract with Friendship Home, Inc., to provide funding in the amount of \$12,427 for an African American Children's Advocate for the Children in Shelter program. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0485)
- J. Grant contract with the Family Service Association of Lincoln to provide funding in the amount of \$30,000 for the Behavioral Health program. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0486)
- K. Grant contract with the Family Service Association to provide funding in the amount of \$17,330 for the Behavioral Health Service Expansion in Lancaster County. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0487)
- L. Federal Grant Award 13-JA-604 from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice in the amount of \$27,521 for the Lancaster County JABG (Juvenile Accountability Block Grant). The federal share is \$19,254 with the County matching \$8,267. (C-14-0488)
- M. Federal Grant Award 2014-DC-BX-0081 from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$210,183 for Lancaster County Adult Drug Court Program Enhancements. (C-14-0489)
