C. Amendment to County Contract C-13-0481 with Midwest Service and Sales Company for the annual supply of grader blades. The amendment renews the agreement for an additional one-year term from September 1, 2014, to August 31, 2015. (C-14-0479)

 D. Agreement between Kodak Alaris and Lancaster County, on behalf of Records and Information Management, for equipment maintenance. The County will pay \$9,657 for the services. The agreement is effective upon execution until September 30, 2015. (C-14-0480)

E. Agreement with Southeast Community College to conduct five-week sessions of on-site food handling and food preparation instruction for Lancaster County Corrections inmates. The County will pay up to \$9,697.50. Term of the agreement is September 23, 2014, to July 30, 2015. (C-14-0481)

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Amundson seconded approval of the agreement. Amundson, Smoyer, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Raybould was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

F. Agreement with Maximus, Inc., for professional consulting services to provide cost allocation plans and collections from programs which the County operates with outside funding for fiscal years 2014, 2015 and 2016. The County will pay \$8,500 per year for the services. (C-14-0482)

G. Grant contract with the League of Human Dignity, Inc., to provide funding in the amount of \$50,000 for the Center for Independent Living program (\$32,000) and the Barrier Removal program (\$18,000). Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0483)

**MOTION:** Amundson moved and Smoyer seconded approval of the contract. Schorr, Amundson, Smoyer and Hudkins voted aye. Raybould was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

 H. Grant contract with Friendship Home, Inc., to provide funding in the amount of \$28,888 for the Children in Shelter project. Friendship Home will provide \$17,974 in matching funds. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0484)

1. Grant contract with Friendship Home, Inc., to provide funding in the amount of \$12,427 for an African American Children's Advocate for the Children in Shelter program. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0485)

**MOTION:** Smoyer moved and Schorr seconded approval of the contract. Amundson, Smoyer, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Raybould was absent. Motion carried 4-0.

J. Grant contract with the Family Service Association of Lincoln to provide funding in the amount of \$30,000 for the Behavioral Health program. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0486)

K. Grant contract with the Family Service Association to provide funding in the amount of \$17,330 for the Behavioral Health Service Expansion in Lancaster County. Term of the contract is July 1, 2014, to June 30, 2015. (C-14-0487)

L. Federal Grant Award 13-JA-604 from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice in the amount of \$27,521 for the Lancaster County JABG (Juvenile Accountability Block Grant). The federal share is \$19,254 with the County matching \$8,267. (C-14-0488)

M. Federal Grant Award 2014-DC-BX-0081 from the Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, Bureau of Justice Assistance in the amount of \$210,183 for Lancaster County Adult Drug Court Program Enhancements. (C-14-0489)

Kim Etherton, Community Corrections Director, said this portion of the grant would cover reinforcement of support systems, specifically parenting. The second half of the grant, which should be forthcoming, would focus on other enhancements, specifically relationship training.
