Advance public notice of the Board of Commissioners Staff Meeting was posted on the County-City Building bulletin board and the Lancaster County, Nebraska, web site and provided to the media on March 5, 2014.

The Chair noted the location of the Open Meetings Act and opened the meeting at 8:32 a.m.

AGENDA ITEM

1 APPROVAL OF THE FEBRUARY 27, 2014 STAFF MEETING MINUTES

MOTION:

Amundson moved and Raybould seconded approval of the February 27, 2014 Staff Meeting minutes. Raybould, Amundson and Hudkins voted aye. Schorr abstained from voting. Smoyer was absent from voting. Motion carried 3-0, with one abstention.

2 ADDITIONS TO AGENDA

- A. County Government Month
- B. National Association of County Officials (NACo) Conference

MOTION: Schorr moved and Raybould seconded approval of the additions to the agenda. Amundson, Raybould, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Smoyer was absent from voting. Motion carried 4-0.

3 **LEGISLATIVE UPDATE -** Gordon Kissel and Joe Kohout, Kissel/E&S Associates (Legislative Consultants)

Joe Kohout, Kissel/E&S Associates, presented a legislative update, noting bills that relate to the County's legislative priorities and other legislation of potential interest to the County (Exhibits A and B).

Smoyer arrived at the meeting at 8:36 a.m.

Kohout reported on an amendment to Legislative Bill (LB) 464 (Change court jurisdiction over juveniles and indictment procedures) to address some of the concerns that resulted from implementation of LB 561 (Changed provisions and transferred responsibilities regarding the juvenile justice system) (2013 Legislative Session). Sheli Schindler, Youth Services Center (YSC) Director, appeared and said the amendment addresses detention and reimbursement issues and decreases the County's responsibilities for costs. The State will be responsible for costs upon adjudication, including adjudication costs for youth in the community, if the legislation passes. Sara Hoyle, Juvenile Justice Coordinator, appeared and said there are still concerns regarding community aid that need to be addressed, noting funding for office space, equipment and supplies has been eliminated. She said the Nebraska Crime Commission also has concerns. Schindler noted funds can be used for existing programs. Kohout said the Nebraska Association of County Officials (NACO) has agreed to the amendment and said "this is what it's going to be."

In response to a question from Hudkins, Kohout said this will bring the level of funding for implementation of LB 561 up to \$10,000,000. He noted there is approximately \$14,000,000 being set aside for the adult component.

Joe Kelly, County Attorney, appeared and said he is waiting to see where juvenile cases will be filed and if there will be changes to how truancy is addressed. Kohout said an amendment that addresses the truancy component was filed on March 4th (AM 2164).

Schindler noted there will also be changes in representation for juveniles. Kelly added that could have a fiscal impact.

John Watson, Deputy County Attorney, and Norm Agena, County Assessor/Register of Deeds, appeared and discussed LB 885 (Require the use of the income approach to value certain real property for tax purposes). Watson explained the bill would enable County Assessors to apply a developer discount to vacant lots, a practice Lancaster County had as recently as 2012. He said his office had issued a legal opinion that the practice was inconsistent with Nebraska law and the County Assessor removed the discount in 2013. Agena noted Douglas and Sarpy Counties provide a developer discount, but not in the same manner.

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICER REPORT

A. Pledge of Allegiance

There was consensus to begin reciting the Pledge of Allegiance at the start of the County Board of Commissioners Meetings.

B. Visitors Improvement Fund Grant Request from the Nebraska High School Sports Hall of Fame (\$19,780)

MOTION: Amundson moved and Smoyer seconded to refer the request to the Visitors Promotion Committee (VPC) for review and recommendation. Smoyer, Schorr, Amundson, Raybould and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

C. Extension of Completion Date for Visitors Improvement Fund Grant Contract with Spring Creek Prairie

There was consensus to schedule an addendum to extend the completion date through August, 2014 on the March 11, 2014 County Board of Commissioners Meeting agenda.

D. First Friday Art Exhibit in County-City Building

The Board concurred with a suggestion from Cori Beattie, Deputy County Clerk, to recognize those artists whose artwork is exhibited as part of the First Friday Art Exhibit in the County-City Building. Beattie said the County Clerk's Office is willing to coordinate scheduling a special presentation at a County Board of Commissioners Meeting. It was also suggested that the Public Building Commission (PBC) make information regarding the exhibit more visible on the County's website.

ADDITIONS TO AGENDA

A. County Government Month

Schorr suggested the Board participate in community service during the month of April in recognition of County Government Month and said she will work with Kit Boesch, Human Services Administrator, to identify opportunities.

4 LANCASTER COUNTY INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS FOR INDEPENDENT CONTRACTORS - Dr. Mitchel Herian, PhD, University of Nebraska Public Policy Center

Item was dropped from the agenda.

5 LOCATION OF COUNTY MOTOR VEHICLE TITLES - Sue Eckley, County Risk Manager; Andy Stebbing, County Treasurer; Bill Jarrett, Chief Deputy County Treasurer

Sue Eckley, County Risk Manager, said some departments have the titles for their vehicles and others are held at the County Treasurer's Office. She maintains an inventory of all County vehicles, for insurance purposes. Bill Jarrett, Chief Deputy County Treasurer, said he researched the titles held in the Treasurer's Office and found some of them were sold and transferred with duplicate titles.

Hudkins said the Board had directed a number of years ago that all titles be in the County's name and held in a central location, although a written policy was never developed.

Andy Stebbing, County Treasurer, said all of the titles could be kept at the Motor Vehicle Department. He added additional staff may be required if his department is called upon to pull titles for County-owned vehicles that are being sold or transferred.

Eckley suggested a review of the titles to make sure they are properly titled in the County's name.

Gwen Thorpe, Deputy Chief Administrative Officer, said a classification can also be established in TRIM, the County's electronic records management system, to help track the vehicles.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Smoyer seconded to establish a written policy directing all vehicle and equipment titles to be titled in the name of Lancaster County and designating the Motor Vehicle Department as the depository for all the titles.

Discussion at a Management Team Meeting was also suggested.

ROLL CALL: Amundson, Raybould, Smoyer, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

DISCUSSION OF BOARD MEMBER MEETINGS

A. Chamber Coffee - Amundson, Schorr, Smoyer

Amundson said they discussed a number of issues, including legislation, tourism, the Mayor's proposal for a half-cent hike in the City's sales tax, Lincoln Public Schools (LPS) graduation rates and writing scores, and the search for a new University of Nebraska President.

PURCHASE OF TWO FOUR-WHEEL DRIVE VEHICLES - Norm Agena, County Assessor/Register of Deeds

Norm Agena, County Assessor/Register of Deeds, requested authorization to replace two-four wheel drive vehicles in their fleet, a 2000 Chevy S-10 and a 2001 Ford Ranger, due to maintenance problems. He noted both vehicles have mileage in excess of 100,000 miles. Agena said he would like to purchase two Jeep Patriots off the State contract for field assessment use, at a cost of \$19,581 each, using savings in his department's budget (\$30,000 in salary savings and \$9,000 left in a fund meant to purchase tablet computers). **NOTE:** The Assessor's Office was able to purchase the tablets at a lower cost than originally anticipated.

Schorr asked whether the purchase could be delayed until next year. Agena said he won't have the funds then. He added he should not have a need for any additional vehicles for the next ten years.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Amundson seconded to authorize the purchase, with funding through the County Assessor/Register of Deeds' budget.
Raybould, Amundson, Smoyer, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

ADDITIONS TO THE AGENDA

B. National Association of County Officials (NACo) Conference

Raybould reported on her attendance at the NACo Legislative Conference in Washington D.C. and said topics discussed included justice reform; highway, bridge and road funding; and how Medicaid expansion can impact correctional facilities.

7 ADULT AND JUVENILE PROBATION SPACE NEEDS - Don Killeen, County Property Manager; Lori Griggs, Chief Juvenile Probation Officer; Gene Cotter, Chief Probation Officer, Adult Probation

Don Killeen, County Property Manager, said a solution to Juvenile and Adult Probation's space needs has been worked out. He said Juvenile Probation Officers who are currently located in the K Street Building (440 South 8th Street) will be moved to the Heritage Square Office Building (421 South 9th Street), where the rest of Juvenile Probation is located. Adult Probation will be moved temporarily into the space being vacated in the K Street Building from the former Lancaster County Adult Detention Facility (605 South 10th Street) while Phase I of the remodel of that building takes place. He said there will be no substantial change to Juvenile Probation's budget and there will be a slight decrease to Adult Probation's budget as a result of the moves.

There was consensus to proceed as outlined. **NOTE:** The leases will be with the Public Building Commission (PBC).

Killeen also indicated plans to give notice (12 months) to Alfred Benesh & Company to vacate 825 J Street. **NOTE:** The Mental Health Crisis Center will be relocated to that building.

ACTION ITEMS

A. Administrative Directive for Non-Qualified Default Investment Alternative

Eagan said Prudential has agreed to divide default investors into two groups and allow those that have the Gibralter Stable Value Fund as their default investment fund alternative to stay there and move employees hired after a certain date who fail to designate an investment to the Goalmaker Conservative Fund.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Smoyer seconded to authorize signature by the Chair. Smoyer, Schorr, Amundson, Raybould and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

8 POTENTIAL AND PENDING LITIGATION - Richard Grabow, Deputy County Attorney

MOTION: Schorr moved and Smoyer seconded to enter Executive Session at 9:50 a.m. for the purpose of protecting the public interest with regards to potential and pending litigation.

The Chair restated the motion for the record.

ROLL CALL: Raybould, Amundson, Schorr, Smoyer and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

MOTION: Smoyer moved and Amundson seconded to exit Executive Session at 9:59 a.m. Amundson, Smoyer, Raybould, Schorr and Hudkins voted aye. Motion carried 5-0.

Weekly Update on the 2014 Legislature

Please accept this as the eighth of your weekly reports for the 2014 Legislative Session. Today is day 38 meaning there are only 22 days remaining in the 2014 session. Committees have completed their work and now full-day debate has commenced. Debate is now limited in scope to priority measures.

2014 Lancaster County Legislative Priorities:

- 1. Oppose Elimination of the Inheritance Tax: As mentioned in previous reports, two measures eliminating the inheritance tax have been introduced. Senator Tom Hansen introduced LB812, which would terminate the inheritance tax for those dying after December 31, 2015. In addition, Senator Tom Carlson introduced LB960 which would make two changes to rates of inheritance tax cutting, approximately, in half those in categories two and three (from 13% to 7% category 2 and from 18% to 9% those in category 3). The board has taken a position of opposition to both of these measures. Neither has moved from Committee.
- 2. Support Medicaid Expansion under the Affordable Care Act: LB887, introduced by Senator Kathy Campbell, was advanced by the Health and Human Services Committee. Senator Campbell has declared it to be her personal priority bill and thus guaranteeing it debate this session. We have not been advised of a likely date for General File debate.
- 3. Monitor the Implementation of 2013 Neb. Laws LB561: As you will recall from previous reports, an amendment was prepared to LB464 that would address some concerns that have resulted from the implementation of LB561. That amendment was sent to us last Friday. It has been reviewed by Sheli and Kerry and the amendment is good for Lancaster County since LB464 was prioritized by Senator Ashford, guaranteeing that it will come back up this session. As we read the amendment, it does the following:

AM2142: This amendment would clean up language in NERS 14-607, regarding police officers and their duty to report hazards to the proper city officials. It

would also amend NERS 24-517, regarding the jurisdiction of the county courts, to transfer jurisdiction over juveniles to juvenile courts in any county which has established such a court system. The amendment would also alter NERS 24-1007, regarding the duties of the State Court Administrator, to institute a new annual reporting requirement on juveniles in Nebraska's justice system as specified. The arraignment procedures in county or district court, detailed in NERS 29-1816, are amended to provide that the county or district court must inform a minor of their ability to request a transfer of the case to a juvenile court. If the accused was a minor, the County Attorney is empowered to offer diversion or mediation. The Department of Health and Human Services must enter into an agreement with the Office of Probation Administration to act as a surrogate of the Department of Health and Human Services to administer the Title IV-E state plan (state plan for foster care and adoption). The office has placement and care responsibility for juveniles in out-of-home or foster care placements, and must develop an individual care plan.

The amendment would also alter NERS 43-247, regarding the jurisdiction of the juvenile court system. Any juvenile who is under 16 years of age at the time they allegedly committed a misdemeanor offense, were a state ward, were abandoned, or committed an alleged felony while under 14 years of age. The juvenile court will have original jurisdiction if a person was between ages 16 and the age of majority and is accused of a misdemeanor, or is between the ages of 14 and the age of majority and allegedly commits (most) felonies. The juvenile court would have concurrent jurisdiction with a county or district court for traffic offenses and other specified hearings. If the court has original or concurrent jurisdiction, transfer is possible. The legislation will also amend NERS 43-258, regarding a preadjudication physical and mental evaluation for a juvenile. The Office of Probation Administration must arrange the evaluation, if ordered by a court. Copies of the report will be provided to the parties to the case. City Attorneys are empowered to offer mediation, same as County Attorneys. If the County Attorney seeks to transfer a case from the juvenile court, they must overcome the burden (preponderance of the evidence) in order to do so. When deciding whether to permit the transfer, the court must consider the best interests of the juvenile; public safety; and the juvenile's ability to appreciate the nature and seriousness of his or her conduct, in addition to the other factors previously provided in NERS 43-276.

The bill would also alter NERS 43-286, regarding potential criminal sanctions for juveniles. Only when a juvenile has exhausted all levels for community based supervision or parole may motion be made to commit them to a YRTC. When a juvenile leaves the YRTC, they must have an individualized reentry plan.

Particularly important is Section 20, which details funding. The County will pay for the services prior to adjudication, Probation Administration will fund the period from adjudication through the termination of court supervision, and the The Office of Juvenile Services of the Department of Health and Human Services



shall pay for any period of time from when the court commits the juvenile to the Office of Juvenile Services until the continued disposition hearing at which the Office of Juvenile Services is discharged by the court. The amount to be paid by a county for education shall not exceed the average cost for education of a public school student in the county in which the juvenile is placed and shall be paid only for education in kindergarten through grade twelve. The Office of Probation Administration is deemed to have placement and care responsibility for the juvenile whenever any juvenile is placed on juvenile probation following an adjudication. The Office of Probation Administration may transition a juvenile to a less restrictive placement after filing notice with the court, and subject to court approval. Importantly, the juvenile court is permitted to retain jurisdiction over a juvenile and may continue the dispositional phase of the adjudication until such juvenile becomes twenty-one years of age if the court finds the continuation to be in the best interests of such juvenile and the juvenile has given his or her informed consent to the continuation. The Office of Juvenile Services must begin implementing evidence-based practices, policies, and procedures by January 15, 2016, and must annually report to the Governor, the Legislature, and the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court.

There is \$5 million appropriated to the Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Program. Funds provided through the Community-based Juvenile Services Aid Program, must be used to transition juveniles away from detention, and cannot be used for construction of a juvenile detention center.

- 4. Eliminate the Responsibility of Counties to Pay HHS Rent LB632: The bill is in the Government Committee. An attempt was made to advance the measure but there were not sufficient votes to advance the bill. We suggest that the measure remain in committee.
- 5. Monitor Adult Corrections Reform. The hearing on LB907 and LB999 were held two weeks ago. We understand that there have been significant re-writes of both of these bills.

2014 Other Legislation:

LB215 (Schilz) Change provisions relating to use of the County Visitors Promotion Fund. *This bill was sent to the Governor.*

POSITION: Support as amended.

LB925 (Coash) Provide for transfer of motor vehicle registration duties to county treasurers. This is Treasurer Stebbings bill that would authorize counties to opt out of the DMV's motor vehicle registration program.

POSITION: Support. Hearing was held on February 24, 2014 before the Transportation and Telecommunications Committee. The bill has not advanced.



LB885 (Harr) Require the use of the income approach to value certain real property for tax purposes. Introduced by Senator Burke Harr of Omaha, he indicated that this came out of some concerns he heard about practices in Lancaster County. There has been communication from County Assessor Agena and Senator Harr's office. Those in support of this bill include the Realtors, Developers, LIBA and others. This is something that according to supporters is being done to address a difference in how Lancaster County is valuing property versus how the other 92 counties are.

POSITION: Monitor. This bill saw a significant amount of support at the hearing and no-one appeared in opposition. Those appearing in support included Roger Morrisey, the Douglas County Assessor.

LB1092 (Dubas) Authorize issuance of highway construction bonds. This bill would authorize the issuance of bonds under the Nebraska Highway Bond Act, not to exceed \$400m in principal and \$30m in annual debt service for a period of not more than nineteen years, in order to accelerate completion of the highway construction projects identified and to be identified for funding under the Build Nebraska Act. The bonds will be issued on the recommendation of the Department of Roads/. At least 25% of the proceeds the bonds will be used for construction of the expressway system and federally designated high priority corridors as determined by NDOR. The remaining proceeds will be used to pay for surface transportation projects of the highest priority as determined by NDOR. The bonds will be paid off by June 30, 2033. The bonds will be exempt from state income tax. The proceeds from the sale of the bonds will be deposited in the Highway Cash Fund for use pursuant to the Build Nebraska Act. If these bonds are issued, all motor vehicle fuel taxes, diesel fuel taxes, compressed fuel taxes, and alternative fuel fees related to highway use, motor vehicle registration fees, and other highway-user taxes which are collected by the state in the Highway Trust Fund are irrevocably pledged for the terms of the bonds issued after July 1, 2014, to the payment of the principal, interest, and redemption premium, if any, of these bonds as they mature and become due at maturity or prior redemption and for any reserves for such bonds. An amendment was offered at the hearing to transition the committed funds from the Highway Trust Fund to the Highway Cash Fund.

POSITION: Support. The bill is on the agenda for potential debate this week. Senator Dubas prioritized it.

LB734 (Schumacher) Provide for deposit of public funds with credit unions. Allows for public funds to be deposited in qualifying state and federally chartered credit unions, as well as banks. The hearing on this measure was held last week. The proponents are trying to move the bill out of committee but have not been successful yet.

POSITION: Support.

LB994 (Health & Human Services Committee) Change fees as prescribed for vital statistics. Increases the amount that can be charged by Vital Statistics by \$5 per copy for a marriage certificate. Dan Nolte forwarded a request to include county fees as well. Larry Dix and I visited with Senator Campbell's office before the hearing and Corrie presented an amendment increasing the fee by \$5



POSITION: Support as amended noted above. Senator Cambell would prefer that the bill move forward unamended. She has committed to bringing a bill that would raise the fees next year.

LB661 (Krist) Provide for voter registration on the Secretary of State's website and use of Department of Motor Vehicle records. Modifies the Election Act (Ch. 32) to required that the Secretary of State, along with the Department of Motor Vehicles develop and implement a registration application process which may be used statewide to register to vote and update voter registration records electronically using the Secretary of State's web site, by July 2015. An applicant who has a valid Nebraska motor vehicle operator's license or state identification card may use the application process to register to vote or to update his or her voter registration record with changes in his or her personal information or other information related to his or her eligibility to vote.

POSITION: Monitor. We would note that it has been prioritized and has appeared on the agenda this week. The other bills dealing with voter records have been killed.

LB870 (Bolz) Adopt the Public Debt Recovery Program Act. This bill would enact the Public Debt Recovery Program, which will be administered by the State Treasurer. The Program will create a set off of any public debt which is assigned to the program against a debtor's income tax refund, state lottery prize, state pay, state contract payment, unclaimed property, any other state payment due to a debtor. Public debt is defined within the statute as any liquidated amount due and owing any claimant which has accrued through assignment, contract, subrogation, court judgment, or operation of law, regardless of whether there is an outstanding judgment for such amount. The bill specifically excludes any debts owed to the University of Nebraska or the state colleges, amounts for child support, or delinquent property taxes. Each state agency, court, and political subdivision may assign a public debt of more than fifty dollars to the public debt recovery program, but only after making two attempts to notify the debtor, and the passage of 90 days. The State Treasurer can pay such amounts, and then determine if the debtor is entitled to any income tax refund, state lottery prize, state pay, state contract payment, unclaimed property, or other state payment. If so, the Treasurer will then send written notification to the debtor of an assertion of the rights under the Public Debt Recovery Program Act to all or a portion of the refund or payment. A debtor can contest the amount or validity of the set off, by making a hearing request to the State Treasurer within the prescribed period. After certification of the debt by the Treasurer, they will notify the Department of Administrative Services, which will deduct an amount up to the certified debt amount from the income tax refund, state lottery prize, state pay, state contract payment, unclaimed property, or other state payment due the debtor and transfer such amount to the Public Debt Recovery Program Fund. The State Treasurer will then notify the debtor of the completion of the setoff.

This bill also creates a Public Debt Recovery Program Fund. The bill appropriates to the fund \$500,00 from the State Settlement Fund in fiscal years 2014-15 and 2015-16 and an amount equal to the cost and ongoing maintenance expense to interface with the JUSTICE System from the Supreme Court Automation Fund. The remaining funding for the Public Debt Recovery Program will be through General Funds until the program is self-sustaining through fees. At the end of any fiscal year, if the revenue in the fund from recovery fees exceeds 200% of the administrative cost of the public debt recovery program for



that fiscal year, the State Treasurer must distribute an amount to each claimant equal to the portion of such excess amount determined by calculating the claimant's percentage of the total recoveries during the fiscal year and multiplying that percentage by the excess amount.

Lastly, the bill allows the Tax Commissioner to transmit information to State Treasurer for purposes of this act, without fear of criminal sanction.

POSITION: Support in concept. The commissioners submitted a letter in support of the bill with some potential changes to the bill. The bill has not yet advanced from the Committee.

LB881 (Watermeier) Change provisions relating to death, injury, or property damage to innocent third parties as a result of a police vehicular pursuit. This legislation would amend NERS 13-911, which is a portion of the Political Subdivisions Tort Claims Act, and NERS 81-8,215.01, which is a portion of the State Tort Claims Act. The bill explicitly disallows a passenger in or on the fleeing vehicle from being considered an innocent third party if the passenger:(a) Enters into the vehicle without coercion knowing, or with a reasonable belief, that the driver of the vehicle is under the influence of alcoholic liquor or drugs; (b) Fails to take reasonable steps to persuade the driver of the fleeing vehicle to stop the vehicle; (c) Promotes, provokes, or persuades the driver to engage in flight from law enforcement personnel; (d) Is subject to arrest or sought to be apprehended by law enforcement personnel; or (e) Is engaged in any illegal activity which would itself give rise to an arrest. Note importantly, in case of death, injury, or property damage to any innocent third party proximately caused by the action of a law enforcement officer employed by a political subdivision or the state during vehicular pursuit, damages shall be paid to such third party by the political subdivision state employing the officer, per these statutes.

POSITION: Monitor

LB1094 (Davis) Change a fund transfer to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund. This bill would amend 2013, LB199, 2 section 7; to provide that the State Treasurer shall transfer \$138 million from the General Fund to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund on or before December 15, 2014. Presently, the statute requires the Treasurer to transfer \$113 million.

LB1086 (Pirsch) Transfer cash reserve funds to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund. This bill would amend NERS 84-612, to instruct the State Treasurer to transfer \$115 million dollars from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund on or before December 15, 2014, and on or before December 15, 2015, on such date as directed by the budget administrator of the budget division of the Department of Administrative Services.

LB669 (McCoy) Transfer cash reserve funds to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund. This bill would amend the Cash Reserve Fund (NERS 84-612), by requiring the State Treasurer to transfer \$85 million from the Cash Reserve Fund to the Property Tax Credit Cash Fund by the end of 2014.



POSITION: Monitor. The Appropriations Committee has – in its recommended budget adjustments – has included \$25 Million in additional aid to this program.
