- C. Resolution in the matter of adopting benefits for the Deputy Sheriff Captains in the Unclassified Service. The resolution provides for a payout of 100% of sick leave upon retirement, and deletes the section on parental leave. The resolution replaces and rescinds Resolution No. R-12-0040. (R-15-0029)
- D. Agreement with Homefront Protective Group, Inc., for Criminal Street Gang Identification and Interdiction training, in an amount not to exceed \$5,000. Funding for the training is from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice, Office of Violence Prevention Grant #13-VP-5001 for this purpose. Dates for this training are June 24-26, 2015. Approximately 50 law enforcement officers will attend. (C-15-0310)
- **E.** Grant contract with the City of Lincoln Police Department "LPD" to provide funding in the amount of \$40,000 for a Youth Community Outreach position with LPD. Term of the grant contract is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. (C-15-0311)
- F. Agreement with Southeast Community College to conduct five-week sessions on-site food handling and food preparation instruction for Lancaster County Corrections inmates. The County will pay up to \$10,144. Term of the agreement is July 31, 2015 to August 4, 2016. (C-15-0312)
- G. Interlocal agreement with the State of Nebraska Probation Administration for two probation officers to provide additional presentence investigation report services to decrease the time needed to complete presentence investigations of inmates housed by the Lancaster County Corrections Department. The County will pay \$61,885 for the services. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2015 to July 30, 2016. (C-15-0313)
- H. Interlocal agreement with Educational Service Unit (ESU) No. 18 for educational services to youth detained at the Youth Services Center. The County will reimburse the ESU up to \$934,750 for the services provided. Term of the agreement is August 1, 2015 to July 31, 2016. (C-15-0314)
- Interlocal agreement with the Office of Probation Administration in the amount of \$10,000 for electronic monitoring services as part of the operation of the Lancaster County Juvenile Drug Court. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. (C-15-0315)
- J. Agreement with Legal Aid of Nebraska for the respresentation of indigent parents and juveniles in the Separate Juvenile Court of Lancaster County. The County will pay Legal Aid \$1,337,030 for the service provided. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2018. (C-15-0316)
- **K.** Agreement with Bryan Health, on behalf of its Independence Center, for non-physician substance abuse treatment services for adolescents placed in the Lancaster County Juvenile Drug Court. The County will pay up to \$8,000 for the services. Term of the agreement is July 1, 2015 to June 30, 2016. (C-15-0317)
