

## GRANT CONTRACT AMENDMENT

This Amendment is entered into by and between COUNTY OF LANCASTER, NEBRASKA, a political subdivision, hereinafter referred to as "Sponsor"; and LUX CENTER FOR THE ARTS, a nonprofit corporation, hereinafter referred to as "Grantee".

WHEREAS, the parties entered into a Grant Contract executed by the County on February 14, 2017, under County Contract No. C-17-0107 ("the Grant Contract"), for the Artist Inside program; and

WHEREAS, the Sponsor agreed to and has provided funding for the Grant Contract by expending State grant funds from the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Juvenile Services Grant #16-JS-0419; and

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice has reduced the original grant amount of \$5,619 by 45% (\$2,529) to the amount of \$3,090; and

WHEREAS, the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice has reduced the required matching funds amount of \$1,264 by 45% (\$569) to the amount of \$695.

NOW THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in the February 14, 2017, Grant Contract under County Contract Number C-17-0107 and hereinafter, it is agreed by and between the parties that the following amendment to the Grant Contract be made:

Amend Paragraph 4 of the Grant Contract by substituting the following language:

4. Grant: In order to assist the Grantee in financing the cost of the project described in Paragraph 1 above for a period of twelve (12) months from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, the Sponsor shall make a Grant in the amount of \$3,090 (Three Thousand Ninety Dollars), from the Grants Fund. In addition, the Grantee shall document \$695 of non-federal matching funds used on the program.

Amend Attachment B to the Grant Contract by substituting Attachment C, which Attachment is attached to this Amendment and incorporated herein by this reference.

All other terms of the Grant Contract, not in conflict with this Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.

The Sponsor and the Grantee do hereby agree to all the terms and conditions of this Amendment. This Amendment shall be binding upon the parties, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns, and shall be effective upon execution by both parties.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES**

LUX Center for the Arts, Grantee  
*Artist Inside Program*

The Grantee will perform the following services under this contract:

- Provide studio-quality art classes in ceramics, drawing and painting, textiles, and printmaking classes for youth living at the Lancaster County Youth Services Center.
- A LUX teaching artist will drive the art van to the Center to provide weekly one-hour art sessions for two separate groups of 10 youth.
- 14 classes will be conducted overall, consisting of 6 one-hour sessions each.
- The Grantee’s curriculum-based art lesson plans will be adapted for use with this student population based on student needs and appropriate materials and tools.
- Tools that are appropriate for use at the Center will be purchased; Grantee may not use any tool that could be a potential weapon or can harm a youth).
- Housing units for each class will be determined by the Youth Services Center.
- Youth will self-select to participate in the program to assure those who participate want to be there.
- Projects will be designed to be completed in one or two sessions so students who arrive or leave midway through the classes are able to complete at least one project.
- Prepare quarterly reports and submit to the Project Director, so that all reports will be submitted in a timely manner meeting the grant requirements.
- Notify Project Director of any changes to the program.
- Follow all rules at the Lancaster County Youth Services Center and promptly report concerns to staff.
- Complete training and criminal history review as determined by the Lancaster County Youth Services Center.
- Information and data from the Youth Services Center cannot be released to other parties without prior approval from the Director at the Youth Services Center.
- Provide basic outline of instruction and supply list to the Director of the Lancaster County Youth Services Center for approval.
