

Applicant shall maintain a policy or policies of insurance (or a self-insurance program) sufficient in coverage and amount to pay any judgments or related expenses from or in conjunction with any such claims.

In claims against any person or entity indemnified under this agreement by an employee or the applicant or anyone directly or indirectly employed by the applicant or anyone for whose acts they may be liable, the indemnification obligation under this agreement shall not be limited by a limitation on amount or type of damages, compensation or benefits payable by or for the applicant under workers' or workmen's compensation acts, disability benefit acts or other employee benefit acts.

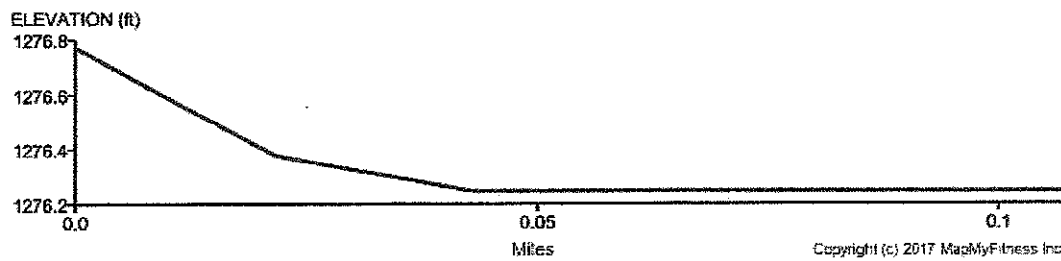
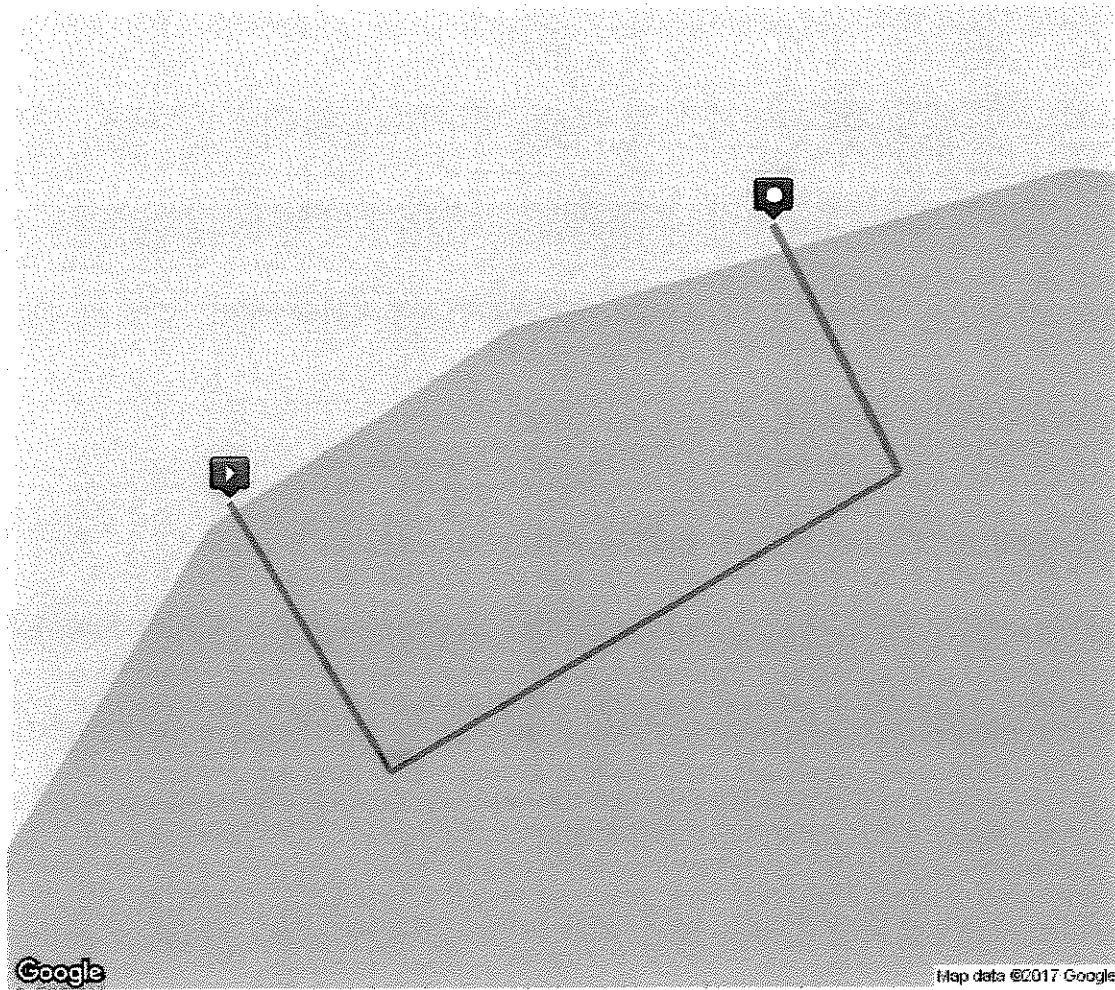


Lincoln Triathlon Super Sprint Swim Course

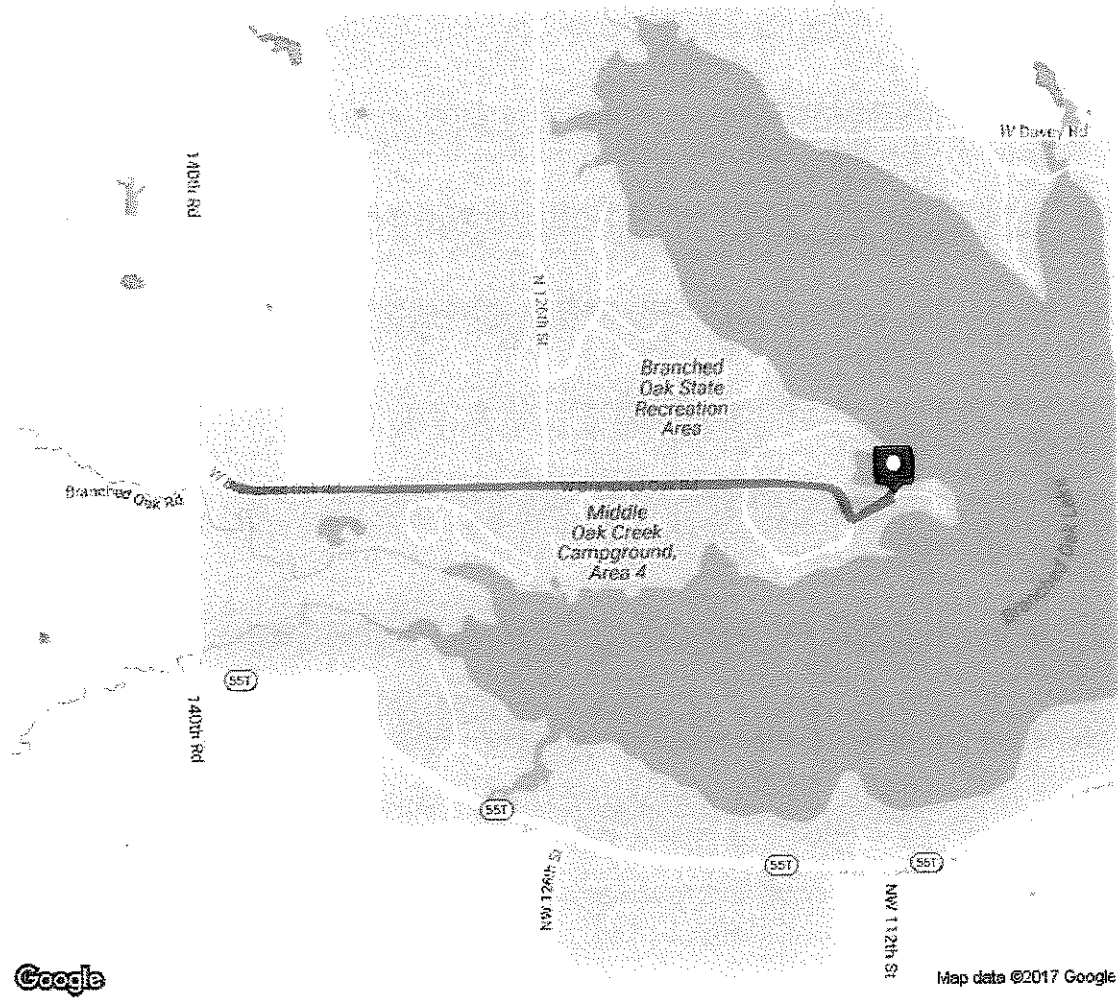

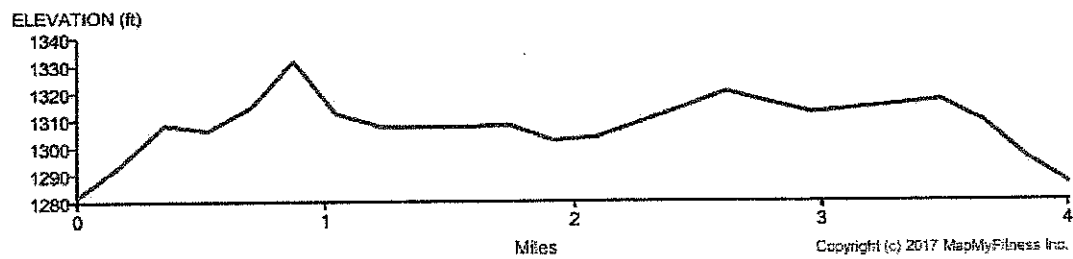

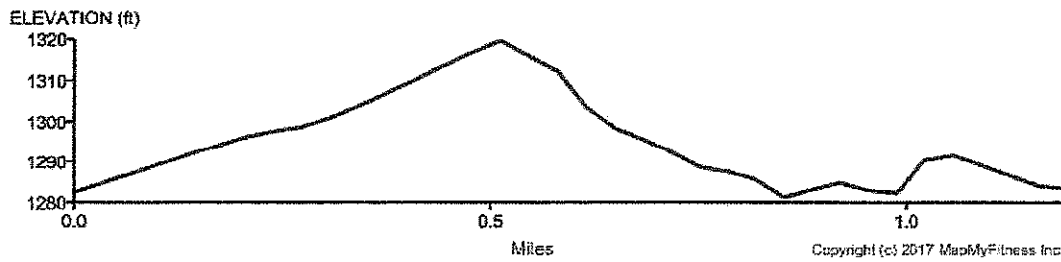

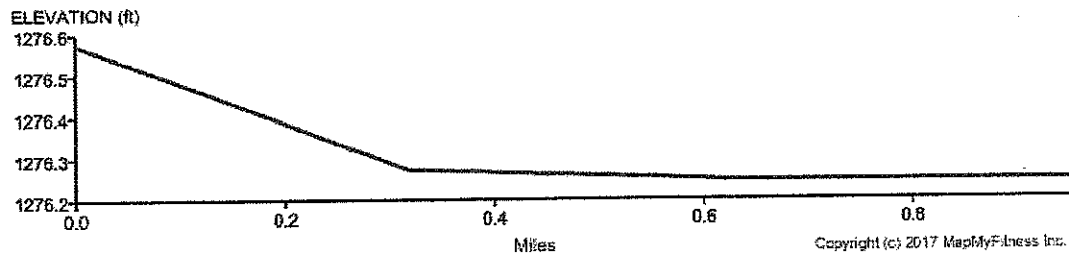

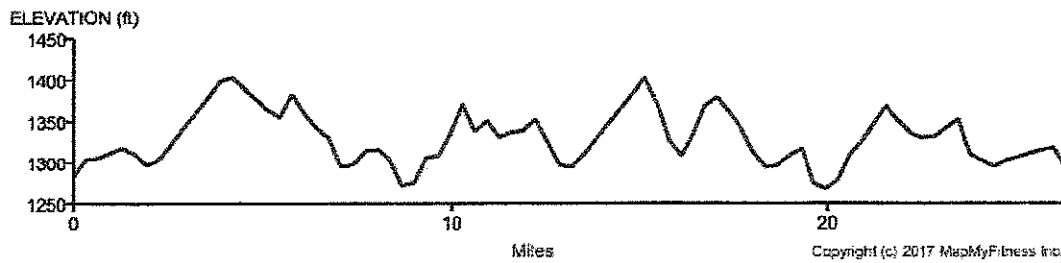

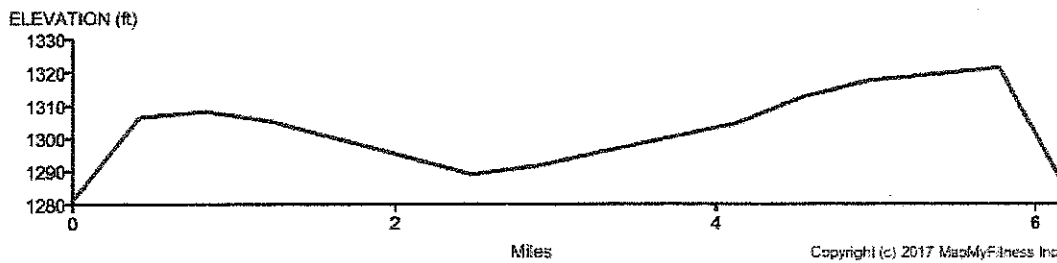

Upon review, this office would have the following comments:

1. No parking will be permitted along the paved roadways during the times of this event. Temporary "No Parking" signs shall be installed at a minimum of four (4) signs per mile, two on each side of the road. These signs may be obtained from the City of Lincoln.
2. No permanent markings shall be allowed on the pavement.
3. Traffic control coordinators should be used at all County road intersections informing the traveling public of the special events in progress.
4. Safety precautions to be reviewed and approved by the Lancaster County Sheriff's Department.
5. Suggest this application be reviewed by the County Attorney's Office for insurance compliance.

Re: Special Events Permits from Tiger Coaching & Personal Training

Dear Ms. Lundgren:

This letter is regarding a request for a Special Events Permit from Tiger Coaching & Personal Training to hold a triathlon "Last Blast Lincoln Triathlon" at Branched Oak Lake. The event will take place on Sunday, September 17th, 2017 from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

In examining the application for the fundraiser we recommend that traffic control be provided at the intersections of NW 98th and W. Raymond, NW 140th and W. Raymond, NW 140th and W. Rock Creek, NW 140th and W. Branched Oak Rd. NW 112th and W. Davey Rd., and NW 98th and W. Davey Rd. The applicant has requested assistance from the Lancaster County Sheriff's Office around the intersections around Branched Oak Lake.

The Lancaster County Sheriff's Office also asks that Mr. Brèdehoff follow the listed suggestions.


- 1) Prior to the event, the organizer must review the course to determine potential problems that could endanger riders and equipment. The organizer is responsible for noting these problems to the participants, and if severe enough, shall cancel the race.
- 2) Crowd control and spectator parking must be addressed. Adequate parking, restrooms, and spectator space must be provided to avoid parking and spectator spill over onto the road and assure safe conditions. Parking and other associated facilities shall be located off highway right of way, unless established vehicle parking areas, such as park and ride lots, are available.
- 3) Riders shall follow rules of the road unless special traffic control is approved and provided.
- 4) Law enforcement officers should be used to control major traffic intersections involved

in the race course. Approaches to all intersections controlled by corner marshals should display advance warning signs. If special traffic control is used, trained flaggers or marshals shall be placed at intersections where cyclists will be disregarding the traffic control devices. Corner marshals will also be needed at the turnaround point and at the Start-Finish line.

- 5) Any individuals involved in directing traffic shall wear a Class 2 high-visibility vest meeting American National Safety Institute (ANSI) standards.
- 6) Event organizers are responsible for clean-up of the race course after the bicycle race event. This includes removal of water bottles, food bags, and other race litter along the course.

The Lancaster County Sheriff's Office has no statutory objections to this permit if Gary Bredehoft follows the listed suggestions. This event has been held previous years with no issues.
