Dear Mr. Walla:

The purpose of this letter is to provide you with the recommendation of the Lancaster County, Juvenile, and District Courts for the replacement of courtroom audio equipment as specified in the above bid. The administrators for all of the courts would unanimously recommend Midwest Sound & Lighting be awarded supplier for this project.

The lowest bid, MaestroVision, did not include any of the equipment listed in the specifications. Instead this company only listed equipment and software that was specifically excluded and is currently required to be supplied by each individual court reporter at no cost to the County.

Midwest included schematics of the courtrooms, demonstrates knowledge of the current and proposed system, and offers one solution for all courtrooms which would make servicing and troubleshooting much easier in the future. They also appear to have met all of the specifications contained in the bid.
