- 1) The parties hereby renew the Contract for an additional one (1) year term beginning November 17, 2017 through November 16, 2018.
- 2) "Contracted Vendors" shall mean all vendors who contract or who have contracted with Lancaster County pursuant to Bid No. 15-224 for Annual Requirements Motor Grader Snow Removal Services for Lancaster County.
- 3) "Contracts" shall mean the collective contracts entered into between Lancaster County and the Contracted Vendors pursuant to Bid No. 15-224 for Annual Requirements - Motor Grader Snow Removal Services for Lancaster County.
- 4) The expenditures for the Lancaster County Engineering Department for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$45,000.00 for Contracts without approval by the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners.

But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insurance qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

- 2. "Bodily injury" or "property damage" arising out of the sole negligence of the additional insured.
- 3. "Property damage" to:
 - a. Property owned, used or occupied by or rented to the additional insured; or
 - b. Property in the care, custody or control of the additional insured or over which the additional insured is for any purpose exercising physical control.

This insurance is excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured, whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis, unless the written contract requires this insurance to be primary. In that event, this insurance will be primary relative to insurance polloy(s) which designate the additional insured as a Nameo Insured in the Declarations and we will not require contribution from such insurance if the written contract also receives that this insurance be non-contributory. But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insured qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

L. INSURED CONTRACT EXTENSION - RAILROAD PROPERTY AND CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTS

Item 9, of SECTION V - DEFINITIONS, is deleted and reptaced with the following.

- Insured Contract' means;
 - a. A contract for a lease of premises. However, that cortion of the contract for a lease of premises that indemnifies any person or organization for damage by fite to premises while rented to you or temporarily occupied by you with permission of the owner is not an "insured contract";
 - b. A sidelrack agreement;
 - c. Any easement or license agreement;
 - d. An obligation, as required by ordinance, to indemnify a municipality, except in connection with work for a municipality.
 - An elevator maintonance agreement;
 - f. That part of any other contract or agreement pertaining to your business (including an indemnification of a municipality in connection with work performed for a municipality) under which you assume the tert liability of another party to pay for "codily injury" or "property damage" to a third person or organization. Tort liability means a liability that would be imposed by law in the absence of any contract or agreement.

Paragraph fudoes not include that part of any contract or agreement:

- (1) That indomnities an architect, engineer or surveyor for injury or damage arising out of
 - (a) Precaring, approving, or failing to prepare or approve, maps, shop drawings, opinions, reports, surveys, field orders, change orders or drawings and specifications; or
 - (b) Giving directions or instructions, or failing to give them, if that is the primary cause of the injury or damage; or
- (2) Under which the insured, if an architect, engineer or surveyor, assumes liability for an injury or damage arising out of the insured's rendering or failure to render professional services, including those listed in (1) above and supervisory, inspection, architectural or engineering activities.

M. CONSTRUCTION PROJECT GENERAL AGGREGATE LIMITS

This modifies SECTION III - LIMITS OF INSURANCE.

A. For all sums which can be attributed only to degoing operations at a single construction project for which the insured becomes legally obligated to pay as damages caused by an 'occurrence' under SECTION I - COVERAGE A, and for all medical expenses caused by accidents under SECTION I - COVERAGE C:

- 1. A separate Construction Project General Aggregate Limit applies to each construction project, and that limit is equal to the amount of the General Aggregate Limit shown in the Declarations.
- The Construction Project General Aggregate Limit is the most we will pay for the sum of all damages under COVERAGE A, except damages because of "bodily injury" or "property damage" included in the "products-completed operations hazard," and for medical expenses under COVERAGE C regardless of the number of:

- a. Instreds;
- b. Claims made or "suits" brought; or

- c. Persons or organizations making claims or bringing "sults."
- 3. Any payments made under COVERAGE A for damages or under COVERAGE C for medical expenses shall reduce the Construction Project General Aggregate Limit for that construction project. Such payments shall not reduce the General Aggregate Limit shown in the Declarations not shall they reduce any other Construction Project General Aggregate Limit for any other construction project.
- 4. The limits shown in the Declarations for Each Occurrence, Fire Damage and Medical Expense continue to apply. However, instead of caing subject to the General Aggregate Limit shown in the Declarations, such limits will be subject to the applicable Construction Project General Aggregate Limit.
- B. For all sums which cannot be attributed only to engoing operations at a single construction project for which the insured becomes legally obligated to pay as damages caused by an 'occurrence' under SECTION I COVERAGE A, and for all medical expenses caused by accidents under SECTION I COVERAGE C;
 - Any payments made under COVERAGE A for damages or under COVERAGE C for medical expenses shall reduce the amount available under the General Aggregate Limit or the Products-Completed Operations Aggregate Limit, whichever is applicable; and
 - Such payments shall not reduce any Construction Project General Aggregate Limit.
- C. Payments for damages because of "bod ly injury" or "property damage" included in the "products-completed operations hazard" will reduce the Products-Completed Operations Aggregate Limit, and not reduce the General Aggregate Limit not the Construction Project General Aggregate Limit.
- D. If a construction project has been abandoned, delayed, or abandoned and then restarted, or if the authorized contracting parties deviate from plans, blueprints, designs, specifications or timetables, the project will still be decimed to be the same construction project.
- E. The provisions of SECTION III LIMITS OF INSURANCE not otherwise modified by this endorsement shall continue to be applicable.

N. FELLOW EMPLOYEE COVERAGE

Exclusion 2.e. Employers Liability of SECTION I, COVERAGE A, is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 2.e. "Bodily injury" to
 - (1) An "employee" of the insured arising out of and in the course of: -
 - (a) Employment by the insured; or
 - (b) Parforming duties related to the conduct of the insured's business; or

(2) The spouse, child, carent, brother or sister of that "employee" as a consequence of paragraph (1) above.

This exclusion applies:

- (1) Whether the insured may be liable as an employer or it any other capacity; and
- (2) To any obligation to share damages with or repay someone else who must pay damages because of the injury.

This exclusion does not apply to:

- (1) Liability assumed by the insured under at "insured contract"; or
- (2) Liability arising from any action or omission of a co-"employee" while that co-"employee" is either in the course of his or her employment or performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

Item 2.a. (1)(a) of SECTION II - WHO IS AN INSURED, is deleted and replaced with the following:

2.a. (1)(a) To your to your partners or members (if you are a partnership or joint venture) or to your members (if you are a limited liability company), or to your "volunteer workers" white performing duties related to the conduct of your business.

O. PROPERTY DAMAGE TO THE NAMED INSURED'S WORK

Exclusion I of SECTION I, COVERAGE A. is deleted and replaced with the following:

I. Damage to Your Work

"Property damage" to "your work" arising out of it or any part of it and included in the "products completed operation hazard."

This exclusion applies only to that portion of any loss in excess or \$50,000 per occurrence if the damaged work and the work out of which the damage arises was performed by you.

This exclusion does not apply if the damaged work or the work out of which the camage arises was performed on your behalf by a subcontractor.

P. CARE, CUSTODY OR CONTROL

Exclusion 2.4.4 of SECTION I, COVERAGE A. is deleted and replaced with the following:

- 24.4 Personal property in the care, custody or control of the insured. However, for dersonal property in the care, custody or control of you or your "employees," this exclusion applies only to that portion of any icss in excess of \$25,000 per occurrence, subject to the following terms and conditions:
 - (a) The most that we will pay under this provision as an annual aggregate is \$100,000, regardless of the number of occurrences.
 - (b) This provision coes not apply to "employee" owned property or any property that is missing where there is not physical evidence to show what happened to the property.
 - (c) The aggregate limit for this coverage provision is part of the General Aggregate Limit and SECTION III LIMITS OF INSURANCE is changed accordingly.
 - (d) In the event of camage to or destruction of property covered by this exception, you shall, if requested by us, replace the property or furnish the labor and materials necessary for repairs thereto, at actual cost to you, exclusive of prospective profit or overhead charges of any nature.

(e) \$2,500 shall be deducted from the total amount of all sums you became obligated to pay as damages on account of clamage to or destruction of all property of each person or organization, including the loss of use of that property, as a result of each "occurrence." Our timit of liability under the endorsement as being applicable to each "occurrence" shall be reduced by the amount of the deductible indicated above; however, our eggregate limit or liability under this provision shall not be reduced by the amount of such deductible. The conditions of the policy, including those with respect to duties in the event of "occurrence," claims or "suit" apply irrespective of the application of the deductible amount. We may pay any part of all of the deductible amount to effect setfoment of any claim or "suit" and, upon notification of the action taken, you shall promptly reimpurse as for such part of the deductible amount as has been paid by us.

O. ELECTRONIC DATA LIABILITY COVERAGE

- Exclusion 2.p. Electronic Data of SECTION I, COVERAGE A, is deleted and replaced with the following:
 - 2.p. Damages arising out of the loss of, loss of use of, damage to, corruption of, inability to access, or inability to manipulate "electronic data" that does not result from physical injury to tencible property.
- 2. The following definition is added to SECTION V DEFINITIONS:

"Electronic data" means information, facts or programs stored as or on, created or used on, or transmitted to or from computer software (including systems and applications software), hard or floopy disks, CD-ROMS, tapes, drives, cells, data processing devices or any other media which are used with stockholically controlled equipment.

For the purposes of this coverage, the definition of "property damage" in SECTION V DEFINITIONS is replaced by the following:

"Property damage" means:

- Physical injury to tangible properly, including all resulting loss of use of that property. All such
 loss of use shall be deemed to occur at the time of the physical injury that caused it;
- b. Loss of use of tangible property that is not physically injured. All such loss of use shall be deemed to occur at the time of the "occurrence" that caused it; or
- c. Loss of, less of use of, damage to, corruption of, inability to access, or inability to property manipulate "electronic data", resulting from physical injury to tangetic property. All such less of "electronic data" shall be deemed to occur at the time of the "occurrence" that caused it.

For the purposes of this insurance, "electronic data" is not tangible property.

R. CONSOLIDATED INSURANCE PROGRAM RESIDUAL LIABILITY COVERAGE

With respect to "bodily injury", "property riamage", or 'personal and advertising injury" ansing out of your ongoing operations; or operations included within the "products-completed operations nazard", the policy to which this coverage is attached shall apply as excess insurance over coverage available to "you" under a Consolidated Insurance Program (such as an Owner Controlled Insurance Program or Contractors Controlled Insurance Program).

Coverage afforded by this endorsement does not apply to any Consolidated Insurance Program involving a "residential project" or any deductible or insured retention, specified in the Consolidated Insurance Program.

The following is added to Section V - Definitions

"Residential project" means any project where 30% or more of the total square toot area of the structures on the project is used or is intended to be used for human residency. This includes but is not finited to single or multi-simily housing, abartments, condominiums, townhouses, co-operatives or planned unit developments and appurtenent structures (including pools, hot tubs, detached garages, guest houses or any similar structures). A "residential project" does not include military owned housing, college/university owned housing or dormitories, long term care facilities, notels, motels, hospitals or prisons.

All other terms, provisions, exclusions and limitations of this policy apply.

S. AUTOMATIC ADDITIONAL INSUREDS - MANAGERS OR LESSORS OR PREMISES

SECTION II - WHO IS AN INSURED is amended to include:

Any person or organization with whom you agree in a written contract or written agreement to name as an additional insured but only with respect to liability arising out of the ownership, maintenance or use of that part of the premises, designated in the written contract or written agreement, that is leased to you and subject to the following additional exclusions:

This insurance does not apply to:

- Any "occurrence" which takes place after you cease to be a tenant in that premises.
- Structural alterations, new construction or domoi ton operations performed by or on behalf of the additional insured listed in the written contract or written agreement.

This insurance is excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured, whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis, unless the written contract requires this insurance to be primary. In that event, this insurance will be primary relative to insurance policy(s) which designate the additional insured as a Named insured in the Declarations and we will not require contribution from such insurance if the written contract also requires that this insurance be non-contributory. But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insured qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

T. AUTOMATIC ADDITIONAL INSUREDS - STATE OR GOVERNMENTAL AGENCY OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS - PERMITS OR AUTHORIZATIONS

SECTION II \rightarrow **WHO IS AN INSURED** is amended to Include any state or governmental agency or subdivision or political subdivision with whom you are required by written contract, ordinance, law or building code to name as an additional insured subject to the following provisions:

This insurance applies only with respect to operations performed by you or on your behalf for which the state or governmental agency or subdivision or political subdivision has issued a permit or authorization.

This insurance does not apply to:

- "Bodily injury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" arising out of operations
 performed for the federal government, state or municipality; or
- 2. "Bodily injury" or "property damage" included within the "products-completed operations hazard".

This insurance is excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured, whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis, unless the written contract requires this insurance to be orimary. In that event, this insurance will be primary relative to insurance policy(s) which designate the additional insured as a Named insured in the Declarations and we will not require contribution from such insurance if the written contract also requires that this insurance be non-contributory. But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insured qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

U. CONTRACTORS AUTOMATIC ADDITIONAL INSURED COVERAGE - COMPLETED OPERATIONS

SECTION II — WHO IS AN INSURED is amended to include as an additional insured any person or organization who is required by written contract to be an additional insured on your policy for completed operations, but only with respect to tiability for "bodily injury" or "properly damage" caused, in whole or in part, by "your work" at the project designated in the contract, performed for that additional insured and included in the "products-completed operations hazard".

This insurance is excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured, whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis, unless the written contract requires this insurance to be primary. In that event, this insurance will be primary relative to insurance policy(s) which designate the additional insured as a Named Insured in the Declarations and we will not require contribution from such insurance if the written contract also requires that this insurance be non-contributory. But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insured qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

V. ADDITIONAL INSURED - ENGINEERS, ARCHITECTS OR SURVEYORS

SECTION II.— WHO IS AN INSURED is amended to include as an additional insured any architect, engineer or surveyor who is recurred by written contract to be an additional insured on your policy, but only with respect to liability for "bodily insury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" caused, in whole or in part, by:

- 1. Your acts or emissions; or
- The acts or omissions of those acting on your behalf; in the performance of your ongoing operations performed by you or on your behalf.

This includes such architect, engineer or surveyor, who may not be engaged by you, but is contractually required to be added as an additional insured to your policy.

With respect to the insurance afforded to these additional insureds, the following additional exclusion applies:

This insurance does not apply to "bod ly injury", "property damage" or "personal and advertising injury" arising out of the rendering of or the failure to render any professional services, including:

- 1. The preparing, approving, or failing to prepare or approve maps, drawings, opinions, reports, surveys, change orders, designs or specifications; or
- 2. Supervisory, inspection or engineering services.

This insurance is excess of all other insurance available to the additional insured, whether primary, excess, contingent or on any other basis, unless the written contract requires this insurance to be primary. In that event, this insurance will be primary relative to insurance policyts) which designate the additional insured as a Named Insured in the Declarations and we will not require contribution from such insurance if the written contract also requires that this insurance be non-contributory. But with respect to all other insurance under which the additional insured qualifies as an insured or additional insured, this insurance will be excess.

WAIVER OF OUR RIGHT TO RECOVER FROM OTHERS ENDORSEMENT

We have the light to recover our payments from anyone hable for an injury covered by this policy. We will not enforce our right against the person or organization named in the Schedula. (This agreement applies only to the extent that you perform work under a written contract that requires you to obtain this agreement from us.)

This agreement shall not operate directly or indirectly to benefit anyone not named in the Schedule.
