

## AMENDMENT

THIS AMENDMENT is made and entered into by and between the **COUNTY OF LANCASTER, NEBRASKA**, a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, hereinafter referred to as "**County**" and **Volunteer Partners**, hereinafter referred to as "**Contractor**".

**WHEREAS**, the Contractor and the County entered into a Grant Contract on May 10, 2016, under County Contract No. C-16-0203 ("the Contract"), to assist in community resource allocation and coordination for the training and education of Adult Drug Court Program participants; and

**WHEREAS**, the Contractor and the County wish to amend the Contract to extend the term of the Contract and provide for additional services during the extended term;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, in consideration of the mutual covenants contained in the Contract and herein, the County and the Contractor hereby agree to amend the Contract as follows:

1. Section 16 of the Contract is hereby replaced with the following:

**16. Term:** The term of this Grant Contract shall be from and after April 1, 2016, through December 31, 2017. Any unencumbered balance remaining on Project Account upon termination shall be returned to County.

2. Attachment B to the Contract is hereby replaced with Attachment B to this Amendment, which Attachment is attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference.

All other terms of the Contract, not in conflict with this Amendment, shall remain in full force and effect.

The County and the Contractor do hereby agree to all the terms and conditions of this Amendment. This Amendment shall be binding upon the parties, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns, and shall be effective upon execution by both parties.

**SCOPE OF SERVICES**

Volunteer Partners

The Contractor shall provide the following services under this Grant Contract:

- Provide and assign a "Coordinator" who will identify and secure available community resources to further the purpose of this Grant Contract. In the event that Contractor changes the assigned Coordinator, Contractor shall notify the Project Monitor in writing of such change.
- Coordinate a minimum of one meeting per quarter between community partners and Adult Drug Court staff for the purposes of recruitment and training. Contractor shall coordinate the meetings with the Project Monitor.
- Enroll a minimum of 15 volunteers for each scheduled training session to receive training on the curriculum(s) identified in Attachment A. The Project Monitor will schedule training sessions approximately quarterly. Contractor will coordinate the timing and progress of its enrollment efforts with Project Monitor.
- Attend monthly meetings with Director of Community Corrections and the Adult Drug Court Coordinator, or as needed.
- Provide input for bi-annual or annual reports, as needed.
- Maintain open communication with Community Corrections Director and Adult Drug Court Coordinator.
