WHEREAS, general supervision and control of the public roads of Lancaster County (“County”) is vested in the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County, Nebraska, (the “Board”) pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 39-1402;

WHEREAS, the Lancaster County Engineer (“Engineer”) in her capacity as County Highway Superintendent, has control, government, and supervision of all the public roads and bridges in the county under the general supervision and control of the Board pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 39-1507;

WHEREAS, the Engineer on May 31, 2018, discovered that Bridge R-210, located on Martell Road between South 110<sup>th</sup> Street and South 120<sup>th</sup> Street, presented a clear and present danger to the public;

WHEREAS, the Engineer temporarily closed Bridge R-210 to mitigate the clear and present danger to the public;

WHEREAS, the Engineer recommends that Bridge R-210 remain closed until appropriate steps can be taken to eliminate the clear and present danger to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Lancaster County that the Board accepts the recommendation of the Lancaster County Engineer, and that therefore the Board, pursuant to its supervisory powers contained in Neb. Rev. Stat. §§ 39-1402 and 39-1507, hereby closes Bridge R-210, to alleviate a clear and present danger to the public.
