
This is our 10th year of putting on this event. We apologize, but we did not know that there was a special permit needed for our event that is required by Lancaster County. We want to do this correctly, hence our special event permit for 2018 and years the afterward. In the 10 years of putting on our event we have never had an incident or a problem out in the county. Most of the course is on gravel roads and the riders will be spread out in smaller groups or by themselves very early in the ride; the riders will not be in a large group. Typically we have about 20% of the registered riders not show up to the event (so even less at the start). Right now we have 348 riders registered. We also typically have a finish rate around 65%, so as the day moves on there are even less riders on the roads. Over the span of the day riders will usually only see on average around 10 vehicles as there is less traffic on the gravel roads (it is actually safer than riding on the highways). Riders come from all over the United States and even a few from other countries. Riders stay at the Graduate Hotel and also spend money at the businesses in the downtown and Fallbrook area. We have full support from Nebco, The Fallbrook Neighborhood Association, Schilling Bridge Eatery and the Fallbrook YMCA (we have donated money the Strong Kids Campaign/Fallbrook YMCA the past couple of years). They will also spend money in the small towns they will be going through or at local small town quick shops/stores. We are proud to be a part of many a small town businesses best day profit wise for the year for them (the grocery store in Malcolm each year). Last year a Boy Scout troop in Valpraiso set up a tent, sold some snacks and water to the riders. The amount of money raised by the Valpraiso Boy Scout troop was enough to help send them on a canoe trip down the Niobrara River. This year we'd like to help that same Boy Scout troop out again and we have also been talking to the baseball team in Malcolm as they are trying to raise money for a second ball diamond.

This letter is regarding a request for a Special Events Permit from Craig Schmidt and Corey Godfrey with the Gravel Adventures to hold a "Gravel Worlds" on roads maintained by Lancaster County. The ride will take place on August 18, 2018, with an alternate date of August 19, 2019. The event will be between the hours of 6:00 am and 12:00 am (next day) and will include approximately 350 participants. The event will start and finish in the Fallbrook Neighborhood in Lincoln. Participants will use gravel roads maintained by Lancaster County (see map).

In examining the application for the "Gravel Worlds" we recommend the following:

- 2) Event organizers are responsible for clean-up of the race course after the event. This includes removal of water bottles, food bags, and other race litter along the course.

Upon review, this office would offer the following comments:

- 1. No parking allowed along County roads.
- 2. Suggest using traffic control coordinators at busy intersections to inform the traveling public of the special event in progress.
- 3. It appears that there are areas of event routes which require traveling along a dirt road. To protect dirt roads from excessive rutting damage due to rainfall, motorized vehicles will not be allowed on dirt roads if they become muddy.
- 4. The following roadway and/or drainage projects may have an impact on proposed event routes: NOTE: Please reference below listed conflicts with attached "2018 Construction Project & Gravel Worlds Bicycle Ride" map along with "EXHIBIT A" (submitted route map with street names added)
- a) There is a drainage pipe replacement project scheduled to be under construction which will require road closings (closing dates are not yet determined). The projects, Culverts F-249 and F-138, are located on N. 1st Street between W. Bluff Road and W. McKelvie Road.
- b) Pavement striping is scheduled on W. Raymond Road from NW 48th Street to N. 14th Street and south along N. 14th Street from Raymond Road to Alvo Road; the estimated completion date for this work is July 13, 2018.
- c) Crack sealing is scheduled on W. Agnew Road from NW 70th Street to Highway 77; this work has not been scheduled but should be completed during the regular work week of Monday through Friday.



- d) N. 112th Street from Little Salt Road to Ashland Road is closed indefinitely due to the closure of two bridges (A-58 and A-59).

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
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
