She verifies that the services and supplies have been received prior to making payment. For attorney fees, she verifies the billing time, rate and authorized expenditures prior to preparing the payment voucher. This is very time consuming but is necessary as errors are identified preventing over/under

payments. This must continue until the automated system is up and going. This precludes overpayments and ensures that all vendors are paid on a timely basis."

Mr. Rezac continues, "As part of her busy schedule, she answers numerous phone calls, provides customer service at the counter answering questions, receipting payments from customers and payments submitted by mail. Even with her busy daily schedule, she still finds time to help the file room and anyone else that needs help."

In conclusion, Mr. Rezac states, "Tammy is a true example of what we expect of our employees in the Office of the Clerk of the District Court."
