MINUTES LANCASTER COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS COUNTY-CITY BUILDING, ROOM 112 TUESDAY, OCTOBER 16, 2018 9:00 A.M.

Advance public notice of the Board of Commissioners meeting was posted on the County-City Building bulletin board and the Lancaster County, Nebraska, web site and emailed to the media on October 12, 2018.

Commissioners present: Todd Wiltgen, Chair; Bill Avery and Deb Schorr

Commissioners absent: Jennifer Brinkman, Vice Chair and Roma Amundson

Others present: Kerry Eagan, Chief Administrative Officer; Ann Ames, Deputy Chief Administrative Officer; Jenifer Holloway, Deputy County Attorney; Dan Nolte, County Clerk; and Monét McCullen, County Clerk's Office

The Chair called the meeting to order at 9:03 a.m., the Pledge of Allegiance was recited and the location of the Nebraska Open Meetings Act was announced.

1) MINUTES:

A. Approval of the minutes of the Board of Commissioners meeting held on Tuesday, October 9, 2018.

MOTION: Avery moved and Wiltgen seconded approval of the minutes. Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Schorr abstained. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 2-0 with one abstention.

B. Approval of the minutes of the One and Six-Year Road and Bridge Improvement Program public hearing held on Tuesday, October 9, 2018.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the minutes. Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Avery abstained. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 2-0 with one abstention.

2) <u>CLAIMS</u>:

A. Approval of all claims processed through October 16, 2018.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the claims. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

3) **NEW BUSINESS**:

A. Resolution in the matter of amending the policy governing the expenditure of public funds for payment or reimbursement of actual and necessary expenses incurred by county elected officials, appointed officials, employees and volunteers. (R-18-0074)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the resolution. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

B. Addendum to County Contract C-16-0649 amending the Visitors Improvement Fund grant contract providing a grant of \$2,810,000 with the Lancaster County Agricultural Society for the National High School Rodeo Finals. The addendum adjusts the completion dates for the phases of the grant project and changes the amount due under phases one and two. (C-18-0630)

MOTION: Avery moved and Schorr seconded approval of the contract.

Wiltgen asked for a status update regarding the construction at the Lancaster Event Center. Amy Dickerson, Lancaster Event Center Managing Director, said this grant contract is being revised, mostly for grounds improvements. The funds from the previously approved contract will be transferred to the second phase and the completion date will be updated.

Kerry Eagan, Chief Administrative Officer, said if the Board approves the contract it would be subject to approval by the Lancaster County Agricultural Society. Dickerson said the Board does not need to approve the contract it would just have to be signed by the Agricultural Society Board.

Wiltgen asked that this item be held until the October 23, 2018 meeting in order to receive a contract signed by the Agricultural Society Board. Schorr withdrew her motion and Avery withdrew his second.

C. Labor agreement with Fraternal Order of Police, Lodge #32 (Corrections), for a two-year period beginning August 16, 2018. (C-18-0631)

Doug McDaniel, Human Resources Department Director, said some language was changed recognizing management of the Corrections Department. The agreement includes a 3.25% wage increase for year one and a 3.0% wage increase for year two.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the labor agreement.

Wiltgen thanked Mr. McDaniel and the Human Resources Department for their work on labor negotiations.

ROLL CALL: Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

D. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and Corrections Department to award a Sole Source contract for Phase 1 VMS Systems Upgrade to Accurate Controls Inc. The total amount of the order is \$80,052.96. (C-18-0624)

Brad Johnson, Lancaster County Corrections Director, said currently they are using DVR's that provide no backup system. The new system will move from DVR recordings to a server, which will eliminate the possibility of losing footage. The funds for this project would be coming from savings carried over from last year's budget.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the recommendation. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

E. Interlocal agreement with the City of Waverly for three Sheriff's Deputies for law enforcement services within the corporate limits of the City of Waverly. Waverly will pay the County \$27,640 per month. The term of the agreement is from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. (C-18-0632)

Terry Wagner, Lancaster County Sheriff, said this agreement has been in place since the 1970's for dedicated law enforcement services in Waverly.

Wiltgen asked who enforces the traffic on Amberly Road, 148th Street and Bluff Road. Wagner said that is a joint decision as they receive information from the City and the citizens of Waverly. Law enforcement takes everything into consideration and tries to develop an enforcement strategy to coincide with the safety concerns.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the agreement. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

F. Mini-grant contract application and award with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety to pay overtime in the amount of \$5,090 for the "Click It or Ticket" mobilization. (C-18-0633)

Wagner said this is an annual highway safety initiative coinciding with the Thanksgiving Holiday and item 3G coincides with the Christmas Holiday. Both contracts reimburse the Sheriff's Office for overtime spent on enforcement actions.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the grant contract application and award. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

G. Mini-grant contract application and award with the Nebraska Office of Highway Safety to pay overtime in the amount of \$5,794.80 for the "You Drink & Drive. You Lose" initiative. (C-18-0634)

MOTION Avery moved and Schorr seconded approval of the grant contract application and award. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

H. Agreement with Child Advocacy Center to conduct interviews and medical examinations of child abuse victims to aid law enforcement and prosecutors in their investigations of child abuse. The County will pay \$20,000 for the services. The term of the agreement is from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. (C-18-0635)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the agreement. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

I. Contract between Tamara Jo Dirks, M.S., L.M.H.P, C.P.C., L.A.D.C., and Lancaster County, on behalf of the Lancaster County Mental Health Crisis Center, for certified alcohol and drug abuse counselor services. The services will be provided at the rate of \$85 per evaluation completed and \$32 per hour for other services. The term of the contract is from September 1, 2018 to August 31, 2019. (C-18-0636)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the contract. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

J. Cooperative agreement with the U.S. Department of the Interior U.S. Geological Survey for joint funding of water resources investigations. The agreement is for the operation and computation of records for four stream flow gaging stations, which are Salt Creek, Little Salt Creek near Lincoln, Stevens Creek near Lincoln and Rock Creek near Ceresco. The County will pay \$12,900 for the services. The term of the agreement is from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. (C-18-0639)

MOTION: Avery moved and Schorr seconded approval of the agreement. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

K. Recommendation from the Purchasing Agent and Lancaster County Engineer to award and execute a Purchase Order for four 2018 or current production year Ford XLT 3/4 Ton E85 Extended Cab Trucks using the State of Nebraska Contract 14653 OC to Sid Dillion Ford Inc. The total amount of the order is \$158,548. (C-18-0623)

Ken Schroeder, Lancaster County Engineer's Office, said this is for four trucks that will be used by the district supervisors which include plowing equipment. The trucks that are currently being used will be passed down to the assistant supervisors and all trucks have been included in the budget.

Avery inquired about the price of each truck. Schroeder explained this went through the bidding process and each will be equipped to handle the required duties.

Avery asked how long the current trucks have been in use. Schroeder said some of their old trucks have about 200,000 in mileage and range from 20 to 25 years old.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the recommendation. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

L. Agreement with The Schemmer Associates, Inc., for Survey, Design, Plan Preparation and Permitting Services of Lancaster County Bridge(s) W-122, W-164 and W-174. The anticipated completion date is January 25, 2019. The cost to the County is \$80,000. (C-18-0628)

Schroeder said these projects were included in the budget and are currently going through survey and hydrology studies. The hope is to have these designed as box culverts instead of bridges. (Exhibit A)

Schorr asked if these projects would be done this construction season. Schroeder said they will hopefully be done in the spring.

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the agreement. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

M. Agreement with JEO Consulting Group, Inc., for Survey, Design, Plan Preparation and Permitting Services of Lancaster County Bridge(s) F-78, F-82 and F-86. The anticipated completion date is January 25, 2019. The cost to the County is \$95,000. (C-18-0640)

Schroeder said these bridges are located on North 14th Street, which is a paved road with higher traffic counts. (Exhibit B)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the agreement. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

N. Grant contract with Girl Scouts Spirit of Nebraska in the amount of \$21,356 for the Lincoln Refugee Outreach program. The contract is funded by the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Juvenile Services Grant for the period of July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. (C-18-0637)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the grant contract. Avery, Schorr and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

O. Grant contract with Lincoln Public Schools in the amount of \$272,422 for the Truancy Diversion program through the Nebraska Commission on Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Community-Based Juvenile Services Aid Grant (#18-CB-0525). The term of the grant contract is July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2019. (C-18-0638)

MOTION: Avery moved and Schorr seconded approval of the grant contract. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

- 4) <u>CONSENT ITEMS</u>: These are routine business items that are expected to be adopted without dissent. Any individual item may be removed for special discussion and consideration by a Commissioner or by any member of the public without prior notice. Unless there is an exception, these items will be approved as one with a single vote of the Board of Commissioners. These items are approval of:

 - 1. County Contract C-17-0858 with Vulcan Signs (Vulcan Inc.) for Annual Supply Traffic Sign Faces (Bid No. 17-239). The amendment renews the contract from November 7, 2018 through November 6, 2019. The cost to the County shall not exceed \$18,000. (C-18-0622)
 - 2. County Contract C-15-0586 with McKesson Medical-Surgical Minnesota Supply, Inc., for Annual Requirements Exam Gloves (Bid No. 15-131). The amendment renews the contract from November 10, 2018 through November 9, 2019. The cost to the County shall not exceed \$8,000. (C-18-0625)
 - 3. County Contract C-15-0576 with MMS-A Medical Supply Company for Annual Requirements— Exam Gloves (Bid No. 15-131). The amendment renews the contract from November 3, 2018 through November 2, 2019. The cost to the County shall not exceed \$12,000. (C-18-0626)
 - 4. County Contract C-15-0149 between Redwood Toxicology Laboratory, Inc., and Lancaster County using the State of Minnesota MMCAP Contract No. MMS14033 for Drug and Alcohol Screening Products. The amendment renews the contract from October 1, 2018 through September 30, 2019. The estimated cost to the County is not to exceed \$30,000. (C-18-0627)

5. County Contract C-17-0860 with PageFreezer Software Inc., for the Lancaster County – Social Media Archive Services (Quote No. 5734). The amendment renews the contract from November 7, 2018 through November 6, 2019. The estimated cost to the County is not to exceed \$6,000. (C-18-0629)

MOTION: Schorr moved and Avery seconded approval of the consent items. Schorr, Avery and Wiltgen voted yes. Brinkman and Amundson were absent. Motion carried 3-0.

5) <u>PUBLIC COMMENT</u>: Those wishing to speak on items relating to County business not on the agenda may do so at this time.


