WHEREAS, the Contract was amended by City Executive Order No. 91213, executed by the City on October 30, 2017, and by County Contract C-17-0839 executed by the County Board on October 31, 2017, to renew the contract for an additional term from November 2, 2017 through November 1, 2018; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereby renew the Contract for an additional one (1) year term beginning November 2, 2018 through November 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the parties hereby amend the Contract to reflect a price increase, per Attachment A; and

WHEREAS, "Contracted Vendors" shall mean all vendors who contract or who have contracted with the Owners pursuant to Bid No. 15-186 for Annual Requirements - Asphaltic Concrete; and

WHEREAS, "Contracts" shall mean the collective contracts entered into between the Owners and the Contracted Vendors pursuant to Bid No. 15-186 for Annual Requirements – Asphaltic Concrete, including all amendments thereto; and

WHEREAS, the expenditures for the City of Lincoln Public Works and Utilities Department - Street Maintenance for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$205,000.00 for Contracts without approval by the City of Lincoln; and

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WHEREAS, the expenditures for Lancaster County for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$27,750.00 for Contracts during the contract term without prior approval by the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners; and

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION of the mutual covenants contained in the Contract under City Executive Order No. 88767 and County Contract C-15-0545, all amendments thereto, and as stated herein, the parties agree as follows:

- 1) The parties hereby renew the Contract for an additional one (1) year term beginning November 2, 2018 through November 1, 2019.
- 2) The expenditures for the City of Lincoln Public Works and Utilities Department Street Maintenance for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$205,000.00 for Contracts without approval by the City of Lincoln.
- 3) The expenditures for Lancaster County for the term of this renewal shall not exceed \$27,750.00 for Contracts during the contract term without prior approval by the Lancaster County Board of Commissioners.
- 4) All other terms of the Contract, not in conflict with this Amendment, shall remain in force and effect.

The Parties do hereby agree to all the terms and conditions of this Amendment. This Amendment shall be binding upon the parties, their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.
