- o Review and revise your plan as needed



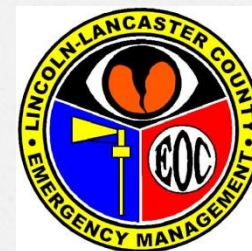
Learn Life Saving Skills

 - o 'Stop the Bleed' training
- o Utilities Shut-offs
 - o Natural gas, electricity, water
- o Smoke/Carbon Monoxide Detectors
 - o Test for Proper Operation



Insurance Check-Up

- o **Key Considerations**
- o Document your property
- o Understand your coverage options
 - o Owner vs. Renter
 - o Home vs. Business
- o Ensure you have appropriate coverage
