RESTORE and SAMI are early intervention/diversion programs to prevent youth from entering the juvenile justice system in an effort to reduce racial and ethnic disparities in our system. Restorative Justice Principles are infused throughout the program. Funding would provide for an existing case manager focused on 12 and 13-year olds and coordination of the School-based Alcohol and Marijuana Intervention (SAMI) program.

RESTORE and SAMI are a collaborative effort between the Lancaster County Attorney's Office, Lincoln Public Schools, Lincoln Police Department and Human Services. They are school based diversion programs aimed at keeping youth out of the formal juvenile justice system while insuring community safety. Youth who receive referrals for assaults, disturbances, or substance use in school are referred to these programs.

Funding is for the existing RESTORE & SAMI Caseworker. Funding also provides for on-line research based interactive classes on substance use for youth participating in SAMI.
