



This letter is regarding a request for a Special Events Permit from James Krist with the UNL Cycling Club to hold the "Husker Hondo" a bicycle race/ride on roads maintained by Lancaster County. The race will take place on July 6, 2019 between the hours of 6:00 am and 7:00 pm and will include approximately 200 participants. The event will start and finish at the Lancaster Event Center, 4100 N 84<sup>th</sup> Street, Lincoln. Participants will use gravel roads maintained by Lancaster County. The race/ride has three different courses with various lengths. Participants will be instructed to obey all traffic laws

In examining the application for the "Husker Hondo" we recommend the following:

- 1) Prior to the event, the organizer must review the course to determine potential problems that could endanger cyclists and equipment. The organizer is responsible for noting these problems to the participants, and if severe enough, shall cancel the race.
- 2) Crowd control and spectator parking must be addressed. Adequate parking, restrooms, and spectator space must be provided to avoid parking and spectator spill over onto the road and assure safe conditions. Parking and other associated facilities shall be located off highway right of way, unless established vehicle parking areas, such as park and ride lots, are available.
- 3) Event organizers are responsible for clean-up of the race course after the event. This includes removal of water bottles, food bags, and other race litter along the course.

The Lancaster County Sheriff's Office has no objections to this permit if Mr. Krist follows the listed suggestions.

1. No parking allowed along County roads.

- 2. Suggest using traffic control coordinators at busy intersections to inform the traveling public of the special permit in progress.
- 3. Currently the City of Lincoln has Havelock Avenue from N 84<sup>th</sup> Street to N 98<sup>th</sup> Street closed for a paving project. Havelock Avenue from N 98<sup>th</sup> Street to N 112<sup>th</sup> Street is being used as a detour for this closure. Please contact City of Lincoln Transportation and Utilities Department regarding allowable access in this area.
