MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING FOR CITY OF LINCOLN, LANCASTER COUNTY, NEBRASKA and CITY OF LINCOLN-LANCASTER COUNTY PUBLIC BUILDING COMMISSION COOPERATIVE CONTRACT MOU048

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING (MOU) is hereby issued to Genuine Parts
Company dba NAPA Auto Parts, 2999 Circle 75 Pkwy SE, Atlanta, GA 30339 hereinafter called "Contractor", from the City of Lincoln, Nebraska, a municipal corporation, and the County of Lancaster, Nebraska, a political subdivision of the State of Nebraska, and the City of Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission hereinafter called the "Owners" for the purpose of the Contractor and the Owners agreeing to the terms and conditions provided in this MOU

The Contractor and the Owners hereby agree to the following supplemental Terms and Conditions from those in the Lead Contract listed above:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

A. PARTICIPATING TERM

The Owners shall participate in the Lead Contract for Automotive and Truck Replacement Parts and Tires with Related Equipment, Accessories and Service. The Memorandum will be effective upon execution through September 6, 2019. Upon conclusion of the initial term, the Owner has the option of renewing under the same terms and conditions for two (2) additional one (1) year terms, not to exceed the renewals allowed by the Lead Contract.

B. SCOPE

The Contractor shall provide the same scope of services and provide the same products as set forth in the Lead Contract.

C. PRICING

Pricing for these goods and/or services shall be pursuant to the Lead Contract, a copy thereof found at: https://www.sourcewell-mn.gov/cooperative-purchasing/062916-gpc. *Using Departments to follow registration instructions posted to set up account.

D. CONFLICTING TERMS

To the extent other terms and conditions attached hereto conflict with the terms and conditions stated herein, the parties agree that conflicts among the documents comprising this Memorandum shall be resolved according to priority, and that a document's priority shall be determined according to the order in which the document appears in the list below in section "E. Memorandum of Understanding Documents".

E. MOU DOCUMENTS

The following documents comprise the Memorandum of Understanding:

- 1. This Memorandum of Understanding and associated Terms and Conditions;
- 2. Copy of State of NE Participating Addendum14778 OC
- 3. Tax Forms

F. LAWS

The Laws of the State of Nebraska shall govern the rights, obligations, and remedies of the Parties under this Memorandum of Understanding. During the term of the MOU, the Contractor shall perform all services and/or supply all goods in accordance with the established and applicable standards and in accordance with applicable State and Local laws.

G. IMPLIED REQUIREMENTS

All products and services not specifically mentioned in this document or the Lead Contract, but which are necessary to provide the functional capabilities described in the Lead Contract, shall be included.

H. CONTRACT MODIFICATION

The MOU shall be modified only by a written MOU amendment and approval of the parties. No alteration or variation of the terms and conditions of this Memorandum shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by the parties. Every amendment shall specify the date on which its provisions shall be effective.

I. TERMINATION

This MOU may be terminated by the following:

- 1. Termination for Convenience. Either party may terminate this MOU upon thirty (30) days written notice to the other party, for any reason, without penalty.
- 2. Termination for Cause. The Owners may terminate this MOU for cause if the Contractor:
 - a. Refuses or fails to supply the proper labor, materials and equipment necessary to provide services and/or products pursuant to the Lead Contract or;
 - b. Disregards Federal, State or local laws, ordinances, regulations, resolutions or orders or;
 - c. Otherwise commits a substantial breach or default of any provision of the Lead Contract or this MOU. In the event of a substantial breach or default the Owners will provide the Contractor written notice of said breach or default and allow the Contractor ten (10) days from the date of the written notice to cure such breach or default. If said breach or default is not cured within ten (10) days from the date of notice, then the MOU shall terminate.
- 3. In the event that funding is not available to continue with services as written, the Owner(s) reserve the right to terminate use of the MOU for convenience with no financial obligation to the Contractor, Subcontractors or other stakeholders except for any amount due for services rendered or products supplied prior to notice of cancellation.

The Owner(s) may terminate this MOU in whole or in part when funding is not lawfully available for expenditure or when sources of funding are terminated, suspended, reduced, or otherwise not forthcoming through no fault of the Owner(s). In the event of unavailability of funds to pay any amounts due under the MOU, the Owner(s) shall immediately notify the Contractor and the MOU shall terminate without penalty or expense to the Owner(s). Upon termination, the Owner(s) shall pay the Contractor for any approved and documented services or products completed or purchased up to the date of termination, but not to exceed the maximum amount allowed by the Lead Contract or this MOU.

J. SEVERABILITY

If any provision of this MOU is determined by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid or unenforceable to any extent, the remainder of the MOU shall not be affected and each provision of the MOU shall be enforced to the fullest extent permitted by law.

K. ASSIGNMENT

This MOU shall not be transferred to/or assigned to another Contractor without prior written consent confirming approval by the Owners. Any assignment without such prior written consent shall be absolutely void.

L. FORCE MAJEURE

Neither party shall be liable for any costs or damages from its inability to perform any of its obligations under the MOU due to a natural disaster, or other similar event outside the control and not the fault of the affected party ("Force Majeure Event"). A Force Majeure Event shall not constitute a breach of the Lead Contract or this MOU. The party so affected shall immediately give notice to the other party of the Force Majeure Event. The Owners may grant relief from performance of the MOU if the Contractor is prevented from performance by a Force Majeure Event. The burden of proof for the need for such relief shall rest on the Contractor. To be released based on a Force Majeure Event, the Contractor shall file a written request for relief with the City of Lincoln/Lancaster County Purchasing Division. Labor disputes with the

impacted party's own employees will not be considered a Force Majeure Event and will not suspend performance requirements under the Contract.

M. ATTORNEY'S FEES

In the event of any litigation, appeal, or other legal action to enforce any provision of the MOU, the Contractor agrees to pay all expenses of such action, as permitted by law, including reasonable Attorney's fees and costs, if the Owner is the prevailing party.

N. OWNER INCLUSION

It is understood and agreed by all parties that "Owner/s" shall include the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County, Nebraska and Lincoln-Lancaster County Public Building Commission. Whenever in the Contract documents, a singular entity is referenced (i.e., "the City" or "the County" or "Building Commission") it shall mean the "Owners" encompassing the City of Lincoln, Lancaster County and Lincoln-Lancaster County Building Commission. Notwithstanding the foregoing, the duties and obligations of the City, the County, and the Building Commission pursuant to the MOU shall be treated as divisible and severable duties and obligations, and default by any one of the City, the County, or the Building Commission shall not be attributed to any other of the Owners, but shall remain the sole obligation of the defaulting entity.

O. PAYMENT

Unless stated otherwise, the Owners will initiate payment within thirty (30) calendar days after:

- 1. All work has been performed and all equipment or other merchandise has been delivered.
- 2. All such labor and equipment and other materials have met all MOU specifications.
- 3. All such work has been approved by the Owner.
- 4. An invoice has been submitted which corresponds with the MOU amount and any subsequent changes approved by the Owners.

P. TAXES AND TAX EXEMPTION CERTIFICATE

The Owners are generally exempt from any taxes imposed by the State or Federal government. A Tax Exemption Certificate will be provided as applicable.

The Water Division of the City of Lincoln is taxable per Reg. 066.14A and no exemption certificate will be issued.

Q. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

Employees of the Contractor shall not be deemed to be employees of the Owners and employees of the Owners shall not be deemed to be employees of the Contractor. The Contractor and the Owners shall be responsible to their respective employees for all salary and benefits. Neither the Contractor's employees nor the Owners' employees shall be entitled to any salary, wages, or benefits from the other party, including but not limited to overtime, vacation, retirement benefits, workers' compensation, sick leave or injury leave. Contractor shall also be responsible for maintaining workers' compensation insurance, unemployment insurance for its employees, and for payment of all federal, state, local and any other payroll taxes with respect to its employees' compensation.

R. EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

In connection with the carrying out of this project, the Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, national origin, ancestry, disability, age or marital status.

Such action shall include, but not be limited to, the following: employment, upgrading, demotion or transfer; recruitment or recruitment advertising; layoff or termination; rates of pay or other compensation; and selection for training, including apprenticeship.

S. E-VERIFY

In accordance with Neb. Rev. Stat. 4-108 through 4-114, the Contractor agrees to register with and use a federal immigration verification system, to determine the work eligibility status of new employees performing services within the state of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program of the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C 1324 a, otherwise known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee pursuant to the Immigration Reform and Control Act of 1986. The Contractor shall not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment to be employed in the performance of this section pursuant to the requirements of state law and 8 U.S.C.A 1324b. The contractor shall require any subcontractor to comply with the provisions of this section. For information on the E-Verify Program, go to www.uscis.gov/everify.

T. CITY AUDIT ADVISORY BOARD

All parties doing business with the Owners shall be subject to audit (City of Lincoln - Chapter 4.66 of the Lincoln Municipal Code) and shall make available to a Contract Auditor copies of all financial and performance related records and materials germane to the MOU/purchase order, as allowed by law.

U. INDEMNIFICATION

To the fullest extent permitted by law the Contractor shall indemnify, defend, and hold harmless the Owners, their elected officials, officers, employees, agents, consultants, and employees of any of them from and against claims, damages, losses and expenses, including but not limited to attorney fees, arising out of or resulting from performance of this MOU, provided that such claim, damage, loss or expense is attributable to bodily injury, sickness, disease or death, or to injury to or destruction of tangible or intangible property, but only to the extent caused by the negligent, wrongful, or intentional acts or omissions of the Contractor, a subcontractor, anyone directly or indirectly employed by them or anyone for whose acts they may be liable. In the event the claim, damage, loss or expense is caused in part by the negligence or intentional act of a party indemnified hereunder, the indemnification by the Contractor shall be prorated based on the extent of the liability of the party indemnified hereunder. Such obligation shall not be construed to negate, abridge, or reduce obligations of indemnity which would otherwise exist as to a party or person described in this Section. Nothing herein shall be construed to be a waiver of sovereign immunity by the Owner.

V. WAIVER

Owners' failure or neglect to enforce any of its rights under this Memorandum will not be deemed to be a waiver of the Owners' rights.

W. THIRD PARTIES

This Memorandum is not intended to, and does not, create any rights or benefits on behalf of any person, whether an individual or an entity, other than the Parties involved. Owners shall not be obligated or liable hereunder to any person, whether an individual or an entity, other than Contractor.

X. AUDIT

This MOU shall be subject to audit pursuant to Chapter 4.66 of the Lincoln Municipal Code and all parties shall make available to a contract auditor, as defined therein, copies of all financial and performance related records and materials germane to this Agreement, as allowed by law.

The Contractor and the Owners hereby agree that all the terms and conditions of this MOU shall be binding upon themselves, and their heirs, administrators, executors, legal and personal representatives, successors, and assigns.

The Contractor hereby agrees to this MOU upon completion of signatures on the Vendor Signature Page.

1. Scope

The scope of this contract is to provide Automotive and Truck Replacement Parts and Tires with Related Equipment, Accessories, and Services per the NJPA contract #062916-GPC to State of Nebraska agencies and political sub-divisions.

- a. CONTRACT PERIOD: May 15, 2017 through September 6, 2020.
- b. PRICES

Prices shall be net, including transportation and delivery charges fully prepaid by the Contractor, F. O. B. Destination. No additional charges will be allowed for packing, packages or partial delivery costs.

c. COMPLIANCE WITH CIVIL RIGHTS LAWS AND EQUAL OPPORTUNITY EMPLOYMENT / NONDISCRIMINATION

The contractor shall comply with all applicable local, State and Federal statutes and regulations regarding civil rights laws and equal opportunity employment. The Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act prohibits contractors of the State of Nebraska, and their subcontractors, from discriminating against any employee or applicant for employment, with respect to hire, tenure, terms, conditions or privileges of employment because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin (Neb. Rev. Stat. §48-1101 to 48-1125). The contractor guarantees compliance with the Nebraska Fair Employment Practice Act, and breach of this provision shall be regarded as a material breach of contract. The contractor shall insert a similar provision in all subcontracts for services to be covered by any contract resulting from this contract.

d. PERMITS, REGULATIONS, LAWS

The contractor shall procure and pay for all permits, licenses and approvals necessary for the execution of the contract. The contractor shall comply with all applicable local, state, and federal laws, ordinances, rules, orders and regulations.

e. IMPORTANT NOTICE

Pursuant to Neb. Rev. Stat. § 84-602.02, all State contracts in effect as of January 1, 2014 will be posted to a public website beginning July 1, 2014. All non-proprietary or non-confidential information as defined by State Law WILL BE POSTED FOR PUBLIC VIEWING.

f. OWNERSHIP OF INFORMATION AND DATA

The State of Nebraska shall have the unlimited right to publish, duplicate, use and disclose all information and data developed or derived by the contractor pursuant to this contract.

The contractor must guarantee that it has the full legal right to the materials, supplies, equipment, and other rights or titles (e.g. rights to licenses transfer or assign deliverables) necessary to execute this contract. The contract price shall, without exception, include compensation for all royalties and costs arising from patents, trademarks and copyrights that are in any way involved in the contract. It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to pay for all royalties and costs, and the State must be held harmless from any such claims.

g. INDEPENDENT CONTRACTOR

It is agreed that nothing contained herein is intended or should be construed in any manner as creating or establishing the relationship of partners between the parties hereto. The contractor represents that it has, or will secure at its own expense, all personnel required to perform the services under the contract. The contractor's employees and other persons engaged in work or services required by the contractor under the contract shall have no contractual relationship with the State; they shall not be considered employees of the State.

All claims on behalf of any person arising out of employment or alleged employment (including without limit claims of discrimination against the contractor, its officers or its agents) shall in no way be the responsibility of the State. The contractor will hold the State harmless from any and all such claims. Such personnel or other persons shall not require nor be entitled to any compensation, rights or benefits from the State including without limit, tenure rights, medical and hospital care, sick and vacation leave, severance pay or retirement benefits.

h. CONTRACTOR RESPONSIBILITY

The contractor is solely responsible for fulfilling the contract, with responsibility for all services offered and products to be delivered as stated in the contract. The contractor shall be the sole point of contact regarding all contractual matters.

If the contractor intends to utilize any subcontractors' services, the subcontractors' level of effort, tasks and time allocation must be clearly defined in the contract. The contractor shall agree that it will not utilize any subcontractors not specifically included in this contact, in the performance of the contract, without the prior written authorization of the State. Following execution of the contract, the contractor shall proceed diligently with all services and shall perform such services with qualified personnel in accordance with the contract.

i. CONTRACTOR PERSONNEL

The contractor warrants that all persons assigned to the project shall be employees of the contractor or specified subcontractors, and shall be fully qualified to perform the work required herein. Personnel employed by the contractor to fulfill the terms of the contract shall remain under the sole direction and control of the contractor. The contractor shall include a similar provision in any contract with any subcontractor selected to perform work on the project.

PARTICIPATING ADDENDUM (Hereinafter "Addendum")

Automotive and Truck Replacement Parts and Tires with Related Equipment, Accessories, and Services Between

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Personnel commitments made in the contract shall not be changed without the prior written approval of the State. Replacement of key personnel, if approved by the State, shall be with personnel of equal or greater ability and qualifications.

The State reserves the right to require the contractor to reassign or remove from the project any contractor or subcontractor employee.

In respect to its employees, the contractor agrees to be responsible for the following:

- any and all employment taxes and/or other payroll withholding;
- 2) any and all vehicles used by the contractor's employees, including all insurance required by state law;
- damages incurred by contractor's employees within the scope of their duties under the contract;
- 4) maintaining workers' compensation and health insurance and submitting any reports on such insurance to the extent required by governing State law and;
- 5) determining the hours to be worked and the duties to be performed by the contractor's employees.

Notice of cancellation of any required insurance policy must be submitted to the State when issued and a new coverage binder shall be submitted immediately to ensure no break in coverage.

j. STATE OF NEBRASKA PERSONNEL RECRUITMENT PROHIBITION The contractor shall not, at any time, knowingly recruit or employ any State employee or agent who is working with the contract or in relation to this contract.

k. CONFLICT OF INTEREST

The contractor certifies that there does not now exist any relationship between the contractor and any person or entity which is or gives the appearance of a conflict of interest related to this contract or project.

The contractor certifies that it shall not take any action or acquire any interest, either directly or indirectly, which will conflict in any manner or degree with the performance of its services hereunder or which creates an actual or appearance of conflict of interest.

The contractor certifies that it will not employ any individual known by contractor to have a conflict of interest.

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ERRORS AND OMISSIONS

The contractor shall not take advantage of any errors and/or omissions in this contract. The contractor must promptly notify the State of any errors and/or omissions that are discovered.

m. ASSIGNMENT BY THE STATE

The State shall have the right to assign or transfer the contract or any of its interests herein to any agency, board, commission, or political subdivision of the State of Nebraska. There shall be no charge to the State for any assignment hereunder.

n. ASSIGNMENT BY THE CONTRACTOR

The contractor may not assign, voluntarily or involuntarily, the contract or any of its rights or obligations hereunder (including without limitation rights and duties of performance) to any third party, without the prior written consent of the State, which will not be unreasonably withheld.

o. GOVERNING LAW

The contract shall be governed in all respects by the laws and statutes of the State of Nebraska. Any legal proceedings against the State of Nebraska regarding this contract shall be brought in the State of Nebraska administrative or judicial forums as defined by State law. The contractor must be in compliance with all Nebraska statutory and regulatory law.

p. ATTORNEY'S FEES

In the event of any litigation, appeal or other legal action to enforce any provision of the contract, the contractor agrees to pay all expenses of such action, as permitted by law, including attorney's fees and costs, if the State is the prevailing party.

q. ADVERTISING

The contractor agrees not to refer to the contract in advertising in such a manner as to state or imply that the company or its services are endorsed or preferred by the State. News releases pertaining to the project shall not be issued without prior written approval from the State.

r. EARLY TERMINATION

The contract may be terminated as follows:

- 1) The State and the contractor, by mutual written agreement, may terminate the contract at any time.
- 2) The State, in its sole discretion, may terminate the contract for any reason upon 30 days written notice to the contractor. Such termination shall not relieve the contractor of warranty or other service obligations incurred under the terms of the contract. In the

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event of cancellation the contractor shall be entitled to payment, determined on a prorata basis, for products or services satisfactorily performed or provided.

- 3) The State may terminate the contract immediately for any of the following reasons:
 - 1) if directed to do so by statute;
 - 2) contractor has made an assignment for the benefit of creditors, has admitted in writing its inability to pay debts as they mature, or has ceased operating in the normal course of business:
 - a trustee or receiver of the contractor or of any substantial part of the contractor's assets has been appointed by a court;
 - fraud, misappropriation, embezzlement, malfeasance, misfeasance, or illegal conduct pertaining to performance under the contract by its contractor, its employees, officers, directors or shareholders;
 - an involuntary proceeding has been commenced by any party against the contractor under any one of the chapters of Title 11 of the United States Code and (i) the proceeding has been pending for at least sixty (60) days; or (ii) the contractor has consented, either expressly or by operation of law, to the entry of an order for relief; or (iii) the contractor has been decreed or adjudged a debtor;
 - a voluntary petition has been filed by the contractor under any of the chapters of Title 11 of the United States Code;
 - 7) contractor intentionally discloses confidential information;
 - 8) contractor has or announces it will discontinue support of the deliverable and;
 - second or subsequent documented "vendor performance report" form deemed acceptable by the State Purchasing Bureau.

s. FUNDING OUT CLAUSE OR LOSS OF APPROPRIATIONS

The State may terminate the contract, in whole or in part, in the event funding is no longer available. The State's obligation to pay amounts due for fiscal years following the current fiscal year is contingent upon legislative appropriation of funds for the contract. Should said funds not be appropriated, the State may terminate the contract with respect to those payments for the fiscal years for which such funds are not appropriated. The State will give the contractor written notice thirty (30) days prior to the effective date of any termination, and advise the contractor of the location (address and room number) of any related equipment. All obligations of the State to make payments after the termination date will cease and all interest of the State in any related equipment will terminate. The contractor shall be entitled to receive just and equitable compensation for any authorized work which has been satisfactorily completed as of the termination date. In no event shall the contractor be paid for a loss of anticipated profit.

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t. BREACH BY CONTRACTOR

The State may terminate the contract, in whole or in part, if the contractor fails to perform its obligations under the contract in a timely and proper manner. The State may, by providing a written notice of default to the contractor, allow the contractor to cure a failure or breach of contract within a period of thirty (30) days (or longer at State's discretion considering the gravity and nature of the default). Said notice shall be delivered by Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested or in person with proof of delivery. Allowing the contractor time to cure a failure or breach of contract does not waive the State's right to immediately terminate the contract for the same or different contract breach which may occur at a different time. In case of default of the contractor, the State may contract the service/goods from other sources and hold the contractor responsible for any excess cost occasioned thereby.

u. ASSURANCES BEFORE BREACH

If any document or deliverable required pursuant to the contract does not fulfill the requirements of the contract, upon written notice from the State, the contractor shall deliver assurances in the form of additional contractor resources at no additional cost to the project in order to complete the deliverable, and to ensure that other project schedules will not be adversely affected.

v. PROHIBITION AGAINST ADVANCE PAYMENT

Payments shall not be made until contractual deliverable(s) are received and accepted by the State.

w. PAYMENT

State will render payment to contractor when the terms and conditions of the contract and specifications have been satisfactorily completed on the part of the contractor as solely determined by the State. Payment will be made by the responsible agency in compliance with the State of Nebraska Prompt Payment Act (See Neb. Rev. Stat. §81-2401 through 81-2408). The State may require the contractor to accept payment by electronic means such as ACH deposit. In no event shall the State be responsible or liable to pay for any services/goods provided by the contractor prior to receipt, and the contractor hereby waives any claim or cause of action for any such services/goods.

x. INVOICES

Invoices for payments must be submitted by the contractor to the agency requesting the services/goods with sufficient detail to support payment. The terms and conditions included in the contractor's invoice shall be deemed to be solely for the convenience of the parties. No terms or conditions of any such invoice shall be binding upon the State, and no action by the State, including without limitation the payment of any such invoice in whole or in part, shall be construed as binding or estopping the State with respect to any such term or condition, unless

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the invoice term or condition has been previously agreed to by the State as an amendment to the contract.

y. AUDIT REQUIREMENTS

All contractor books, records and documents relating to work performed or monies received under the contract shall be subject to audit at any reasonable time upon the provision of reasonable notice by the State. These records shall be maintained for a period of five (5) full years from the date of final payment, or until all issues related to an audit, litigation or other action are resolved, whichever is longer. All records shall be maintained in accordance with generally accepted accounting principles.

In addition to, and in no way in limitation of any obligation in the contract, the contractor shall agree that it will be held liable for any State audit exceptions, and shall return to the State all payments made under the contract for which an exception has been taken or which has been disallowed because of such an exception. The contractor agrees to correct immediately any material weakness or condition reported to the State in the course of an audit.

z. TAXES

Purchases of goods or services made by the State of Nebraska are exempt from the payment of Federal Excise Taxes, and exemption certificates will be furnished on request. State and local taxes are exempt by State Statute Section 77-2704 (I) (m). Exemption by statute precludes the furnishing of State exemption certificates.

aa. INSPECTION AND APPROVAL

Final inspection and approval of all work required and/or goods received under the contract shall be performed by the designated State officials. The State and/or its authorized representatives shall have the right to enter any premises where the contractor or subcontractor duties under the contract are being performed, and to inspect, monitor or otherwise evaluate the work being performed. All inspections and evaluations shall be at reasonable times and in a manner that will not unreasonably delay work.

bb. CHANGES IN SCOPE/CHANGE ORDERS

The State may, at any time with written notice to the contractor, make changes within the general scope of the contract. Changes in scope shall only be conducted with the written approval of the State's designee as so defined by the State from time to time.

The State may, at any time work is in progress, by written order, make alterations in the terms of work as shown in the specifications, require the performance of extra work, decrease the quantity of work, or make such other changes as the State may find necessary or desirable. The contractor shall not claim forfeiture of contract by reasons of such changes by the State.

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Changes in work and the amount of compensation to be paid to the contractor for any extra work so ordered shall be determined in accordance with the applicable unit prices of the contract.

Corrections of any deliverable services/goods or performance of work required pursuant to the contract shall not be deemed a modification requiring a change order.

cc. SEVERABILITY

If any term or condition of the contract is declared by a court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal or in conflict with any law, the validity of the remaining terms and conditions shall not be affected, and the rights and obligations of the parties shall be construed and enforced as if the contract did not contain the particular provision held to be invalid.

dd. CONFIDENTIALITY

All materials and information provided by the State or acquired by the contractor on behalf of the State shall be regarded as confidential information. All materials and information provided by the State or acquired by the contractor on behalf of the State shall be handled in accordance with Federal and State Law, and ethical standards. The contractor must ensure the confidentiality of such materials or information. Should said confidentiality be breached by a contractor; contractor shall notify the State immediately of said breach and take immediate corrective action.

It is incumbent upon the contractor to inform its officers and employees of the penalties for improper disclosure imposed by the Privacy Act of 1974, 5 U.S.C. 552a. Specifically, 5 U.S.C. 552a (i)(1), which is made applicable to contractors by 5 U.S.C. 552a (m)(1), provides that any officer or employee of a contractor, who by virtue of his/her employment or official position has possession of or access to agency records which contain individually identifiable information, the disclosure of which is prohibited by the Privacy Act or regulations established thereunder, and who knowing that disclosure of the specific material is prohibited, willfully discloses the material in any manner to any person or agency not entitled to receive it, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and fined not more than \$5,000.

ee. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

It is understood by the parties that in the State of Nebraska's opinion, any limitation on the contractor's liability is unconstitutional under the Nebraska State Constitution, Article XIII, Section 3, and that any limitation of liability shall not be binding on the State of Nebraska despite inclusion of such language in documents supplied with the contractor's bid or in the final contract.

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ff. INDEMNIFICATION

1) GENERAL

The contractor agrees to defend, indemnify, hold, and save harmless the State and its employees, volunteers, agents, and its elected and appointed officials ("the indemnified parties") from and against any and all claims, liens, demands, damages, liability, actions, causes of action, losses, judgments, costs, and expenses of every nature, including investigation costs and expenses, settlement costs, and attorney fees and expenses ("the claims"), sustained or asserted against the State, arising out of, resulting from, or attributable to the willful misconduct, negligence, error, or omission of the contractor, its employees, subcontractors, consultants, representatives, and agents, except to the extent such contractor liability is attenuated by any action of the State which directly and proximately contributed to the claims.

INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

The contractor agrees it will at its sole cost and expense, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the indemnified parties from and against any and all claims, to the extent such claims arise out of, result from, or are attributable to the actual or alleged infringement or misappropriation of any patent, copyright, trade secret, trademark, or confidential information of any third party by the contractor or its employees, subcontractors, consultants, representatives, and agents; provided, however, the State gives the contractor prompt notice in writing of the claim. The contractor may not settle any infringement claim that will affect the State's use of the Licensed Software without the State's prior written consent, which consent may be withheld for any reason.

If a judgment or settlement is obtained or reasonably anticipated against the State's use of any intellectual property for which the contractor has indemnified the State, the contractor shall at the contractor's sole cost and expense promptly modify the item or items which were determined to be infringing, acquire a license or licenses on the State's behalf to provide the necessary rights to the State to eliminate the infringement, or provide the State with a non-infringing substitute that provides the State the same functionality. At the State's election, the actual or anticipated judgment may be treated as a breach of warranty by the contractor, and the State may receive the remedies provided under this contract.

3) PERSONNEL

The contractor shall, at its expense, indemnify and hold harmless the indemnified parties from and against any claim with respect to withholding taxes, worker's

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compensation, employee benefits, or any other claim, demand, liability, damage, or loss of any nature relating to any of the personnel provided by the contractor.

gg. ANTITRUST

The contractor hereby assigns to the State any and all claims for overcharges as to goods and/or services provided in connection with this contract resulting from antitrust violations which arise under antitrust laws of the United States and the antitrust laws of the State.

hh. TIME IS OF THE ESSENCE

Time is of the essence in this contract. The acceptance of late performance with or without objection or reservation by the State shall not waive any rights of the State nor constitute a waiver of the requirement of timely performance of any obligations on the part of the contractor remaining to be performed.

ii. DRUG POLICY

Contractor certifies it maintains a drug free work place environment to ensure worker safety and workplace integrity. Contractor agrees to provide a copy of its drug free workplace policy at any time upon request by the State.

jj. EMPLOYEE WORK ELIGIBILITY STATUS

The Contractor is required and hereby agrees to use a federal immigration verification system to determine the work eligibility status of employees physically performing services within the State of Nebraska. A federal immigration verification system means the electronic verification of the work authorization program authorized by the Illegal Immigration Reform and Immigrant Responsibility Act of 1996, 8 U.S.C. 1324a, known as the E-Verify Program, or an equivalent federal program designated by the United States Department of Homeland Security or other federal agency authorized to verify the work eligibility status of a newly hired employee.

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

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
