Dear Ms. McCullen:

This letter is regarding a request for a Special Events Permit from Brandon Holscher with the Nebraska Sports Council to hold a "Comhusker State Games Gravel Grinder" on roads maintained by Lancaster County. The event will take place on July 27, 2019, between the hours of 6:00 am and 6:00 pm and will include approximately 100 participants. The event will start and finish at the Roca Tavern located at 4101 Main Street, Roca, Lancaster County, Nebraska. Participants will use roads maintained by Lancaster County. Participants will be instructed to obey all traffic laws.

In examining the application for the "Cornhusker State Games Gravel Grinder" we recommend the following:

- 1) Prior to the event, the organizer must review the course to determine potential problems that could endanger runners and equipment. The organizer is responsible for noting these problems to the participants, and if severe enough, shall cancel the race.
- 2) Crowd control and spectator parking must be addressed. Adequate parking, restrooms, and spectator space must be provided to avoid parking and spectator spill over onto the road and assure safe conditions. Parking and other associated facilities shall be located off highway right of way, unless established vehicle parking areas, such as park and ride lots, are available.
- 3) Event organizers are responsible for clean-up of the race course after the event. This includes removal of water bottles, food bags, and other race litter along the course.

The Lancaster County Sheriff's Office has no objections to this permit if Mr. Holscher follows the listed suggestions.

Upon review, this office would offer the following comments:

- 1. No parking allowed along County roads.
- 2. Suggest using traffic control coordinators at busy intersections to inform the traveling public of the special event in progress.
- 3. It appears that there are areas of event routes which require traveling along a dirt road. To protect dirt roads from excessive rutting damage due to rainfall, motorized vehicles will not be allowed on dirt roads if they become muddy.

Dirt Roads:

- a) W Rokeby Road from SW 84th Street east to SW 70th Street
- b) SW 58th Street from W Bennet Road south to W Wittstruck Road
- c) W Stagecoach Road from S 25th Street west for ¾ mile
- d) W Bennet Road from Highway 77 east for over ½ mile
- e) W Bennet Road from SW 2nd Street east for ¾ mile
- 4. The following roadway and/or drainage projects may have an impact on proposed event route for the Gravel Grinder:

- a) Resurfacing is scheduled on NW 140th Street from north of W Branched Oak Road south to W Raymond Road and south from W Raymond Road along NW 112th Street to Malcolm Road. This work is estimated to be completed by July 19; this work is generally done during the regular work week of Monday through Friday.
- b) Resurfacing is scheduled on Malcolm Road from NW 112th Street through the Village of Malcolm to NW 105th Street. The estimated starting date for work on this project is October 1.
- c) There is a drainage pipe replacement project that is scheduled to be under construction but will not conflict with the current Gravel Grinder route. The project, Culvert M-87, is located just west of NW 105th Street on W Superior Street.
- d) There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Adams Street from NW 105th Street east to NW 84th Street; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23.
- e) There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Denton Road from SW 142nd Street east to SW 112th Street; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23.
- f) Resurfacing is scheduled on W Denton Road from SW 112th Street east to the village limits of Denton. The estimated dates for work on this project are June 28 through August 8; this work is generally done during the regular work week of Monday through Friday.
- g) There is a crack sealing project scheduled on SW 112th Street from W Denton Road south to W Roca Road. The estimated starting date for this project is September 16.
- h) There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Martell Road from SW 29th Street east to SW 14th Street; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23.
- There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Sprague Road from SW 142nd Street east to Highway 77; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23.
- j) There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Saltillo Road from SW 12th Street east to Highway 77; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23.
- k) A drainage pipe replacement project is scheduled to be under construction which will require road closings; closing dates are not yet determined but work can be scheduled at this location to not conflict with the Gravel Grinder on July 27, 2019. The projects, Culvert O-205 and O-46, are located near the intersection of W Rokeby Road and S 1st Street.
- I) There is a pavement striping project scheduled on W Rokeby Road through the intersection with SW 12th Street east to the end of the existing paving; the estimated dates for work on this project are September 2 through September 23. The pavement striping project will also extend north from W Rokeby Road along SW 12th Street.
- m) Resurfacing is scheduled on SW 12th Street from W Rokeby Road south to south of W Saltillo Road. The estimated completion date for this project is July 12; this work is generally done during the regular work week of Monday through Friday.


