RESOTRE is a school-based diversion program aimed at diverting the school to prison pipeline through evidence based Restorative Justice Principles.

Building on the success of RESTORE, SAMI (School-based Alcohol and Marijuana Intervention) was created during the last grant cycle. SAMI allows for youth referred for alcohol and marijuana offenses while at school the same opportunities as RESTORE.
