Line enforcement of theores are required to investigate the death of anyone dring 'unattended.' An autoppy may be ordered if the cause or manner of death are not ready apparent or if the treating physician is novilling to sign the death certificate. Autoppies are required for inflats and chifters. In 2016 we authorized about 202 autoppies and were consulted on 1.593 coroner cases. Consultation can be simple as one telephone call to us from absend coroner to seven alhours of review of the reports.
